The Princess Louise Fusiliers will be conducting a military exercise 4-6 February 2005 within the Halifax Regional Municipality. The Fusiliers request the use of the Halifax Commons fields for the purpose of a landing zone for four Canadian Forces helicopters from 0900 hrs until 1500 hrs 5-6 February 2005.
