On Friday, March 4, 2005, residents phoned the Halifax Regional Police who issued a ticket for violation of the By-Law. However, work continued until Saturday morning at 6:00 a.m.

I will be asking for a staff report recommending what course of action can be implemented by Development Services and HRP to enforce our bylaw and protect the residents.

Also, I will be asking that staff give Council an update on the Springvale situation right away.
