## **ORIGIN**

The Approved 2003/04 and 2007/08 Capital Budgets.

## RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that Council award Tender No. 07-254, Storm Sewer Rehabilitation or Replacement, Crescent Avenue - West Region to Dexter Construction Company Limited for materials and services listed at the unit prices quoted for a Total Tender Price of \$541,967.96 (net HST included) with funding from Capital Account No. CGU00458 - Crescent Avenue, Storm Sewer Rehabilitation, as outlined in the Budget Implications section of this report.

### **BACKGROUND**

The Approved 2003/04 and 2007/08 Capital Budgets includes funds for the rehabilitation of the storm sewer on Crescent Avenue from St. Margaret's Bay Road to Chocolate Lake. The existing corrugated steel pipe has deteriorated structurally. It has reached the end of its service life and is at risk of collapse. The tender included two options for rehabilitating this pipe: (1) lining the existing pipe and (2) replacement.

This project is a Priority Two project, according to the Stormwater and Wastewater Priority Rating process approved by Regional Council in February of 2005.

# **DISCUSSION**

Tenders were called on May 9, 2007 and closed on May 23, 2007. Bids were received from the following companies:

The option recommended for this award is Option #2 (Replacement), as this option has the lowest tender price. The scope of work generally consists of replacing the existing corrugated steel pipe with a new concrete pipe via open trench, and reinstatement of disturbed surfaces.

It is not recommended that Option # 1 (Lining) be pursued due to the higher cost of the contract.

It is anticipated that construction will commence within three weeks of the tender award and take four weeks to complete.

This is a **UNIT PRICE** contract and the cost will be dependent upon the actual quantities measured and approved by the HRM Project Manager.

There are no Local Improvement Charges associated with this work.
