ORIGIN

The Approved 2007/08 Capital Budget.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that Council award Tender No. 07-226, Paving Renewal and Resurfacing, Chain Lake Drive - West Region to Ocean Contractors Limited for material and services listed at the unit prices quoted for a Total Tender Price of \$294,824.36 (net HST included) with funding from Capital Account Nos. CZU00782 - Resurfacing and CYU00784 - Paving Renewal Program, as outlined in the Budget Implications section of this report.

BACKGROUND

The Approved 2007/08 Capital Budget includes funds for the paving renewal and resurfacing of Chain Lake Drive from Lakelands Boulevard to Ash Lake Court.

DISCUSSION

Tenders were called on May 26, 2007 and closed on June 7, 2007. Bids were received from the following companies:

The scope of work for this tender generally consists of the planing, pulverization, adjustment of existing manholes and water valves, paving and the reinstatement of pavement markings.

It is anticipated that work will commence within three weeks of the tender award and take four weeks to complete.

This is a **UNIT PRICE** contract and the cost will be dependent upon the actual quantities measured and approved by the HRM Project Manager.

There are no Local Improvement Charges associated with this work.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS

Based on the lowest tendered price of \$294,824.36, including net HST, funding is available in the Approved 2007/08 Capital Budget from Account Nos. CZU00782 - Resurfacing and CYU00784 - Paving Renewal Program. The budget availability has been approved by Financial Services.
