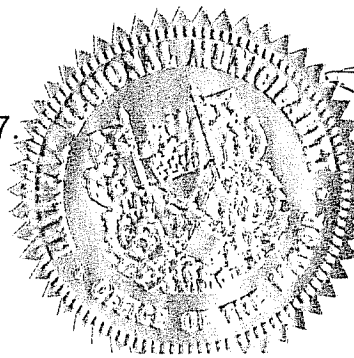



*Proclamation*  
**TEAM H2V DAY**  
**SEPTEMBER 14, 2007**

- WHEREAS A historic national event benefiting the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation (JDRF) and 2 million Canadians kicks off in Halifax, September 14, 2007; and
- WHEREAS On Friday, September 14, 2007, five riders will begin cycling from Halifax to Vancouver, 6,000 km, in 9 days with one goal - cure juvenile diabetes; and
- WHEREAS Team H2V aims to set a world record for the fastest trans-Canada crossing by a team and raise awareness and funds for JDRF; and
- WHEREAS The Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation (JDRF) was established to find a cure for diabetes and its complications through research. Team H2V supports the work of researchers and hopes to accelerate a cure by raising more than one million dollars; and
- WHEREAS Team H2v will unite type one children and their families, the Canadian cycling community who will support H2V by forming a peloton across the country, and will also unite the country with the message of doing something instead of waiting.
