Region

ORIGIN

The Approved Advanced 2008/09 Capital Budget.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that Council award Tender No. 08-202, Sidewalk Renewals - West Region to Ocean Contractors Limited for a Total Tender Price of \$348,555.73 (net HST included) with funding from Capital Account No. CKU01084 - Sidewalk Renewals, as outlined in the Budget Implications section of this report.

BACKGROUND

The Approved Advanced 2008/09 Capital Budget includes funds for the replacement of concrete sidewalks because of their overall poor condition. The locations included in this tender meet or exceed the criteria for replacement.

DISCUSSION

Tenders were called on January 16, 2008 and closed on January 30, 2008. Bids were received from the following companies:

The scope of work for this tender includes the renewal of concrete sidewalk, concrete curb and gutter, and reinstatement at the locations listed below.

- Tower Road (E) Victoria Road to Inglis Street
- Marlborough Avenue (W) Inglis Street to Roxton Road
- Henry Street (E) Jubilee Road to Binney Street
- Waegwoltic Avenue (S) Oxford Street to end of existing sidewalk

It is anticipated that work will commence when weather permits and take five weeks to complete.

This is a **UNIT PRICE** contract and the cost will be dependent upon the actual quantities measured and approved by the HRM Project Manager.

There are no Local Improvement Charges associated with this work.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS

Based on the lowest tendered price of \$348,555.73, including net HST, funding is available in the Approved Advanced 2008/09 Capital Budget from Account No. CKU01084, Sidewalk Renewals. The budget availability has been confirmed by Financial Services.
