And Whereas: The reinstatement of passenger rail, including a mixed rail service

of express and mail and other commodities, may very well create a viable transportation service, while at the same time providing the area with one of the most important ingredients required for the location and success of manufacturing industrial and commercial

sector as well as the traveling public;
