

## Proclamation REVOLUTION DAY

APRIL 18, 2008

WHEREAS, April 18, 2008 is recognized as Revolution Day; and

WHEREAS, Revolution is aimed at raising funds for the Dartmouth General Hospital Charitable Foundation; and

WHEREAS, this is the 3rd year for the Revolution event, which has grown both in participation and funds secured at least three-fold since the first event in 2006; and

WHEREAS, Revolution was the first event of its kind in Canada and was the largest all day spinning-event in the world in 2006. Revolution is now the largest event of its kind in Canada. Funds raised support the 64-slice CT Scanner at the Dartmouth General Hospital – a revolutionary machine that assists doctors in providing top-notch health care to citizens of HRM and decreases wait times for patient scans; and

**WHEREAS**, this fundraising event brings all communities across the HRM together, including individuals, the sporting community and corporate community – all for a cause that benefits everyone in HRM.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT** I, Mayor Peter J. Kelly, on behalf of Halifax Regional Council, do hereby proclaim the week of April 18, 2008 as *Revolution Day* in the Halifax Regional Municipality.
