SUBJECT: Award - Tender No. 08-124R, Parking Lot Paving, 150 Thornhill Dr

ORIGIN

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that Council award Tender No. 08-124R - Rapid Transit Parking Lot Paving, 150 Thornhill Drive to Dexter Construction Limited for a Total Tender Price of \$324,560.20 (net HST included) with funding from Capital Accounts CB100077, CBU00951 and CBX01057, all titled Transit Facilities Upgrades, as outlined in the Budget Implications section of this report.

Approved 2007/08 and 2008/09 Capital Budgets.

The Transit facility at 150 Thornhill Drive has an extensive parking area for seventy-eight (78) buses, which includes 'Link,' 'Access-A-Bus,' standard forty-foot long buses, and community buses. The existing parking area consists of a gravel area that requires substantial maintenance due to the formation of 'potholes,' dust, personnel issues and ice due to poor drainage. Buses are fuelled, cleaned, maintained and stored daily at this facility. Bus cleanliness is an issue due to the mud and dust which result in operator and rider complaints.

This parking area requires paving to provide an acceptable standard of public comfort, operator safety, and lot maintenance costs.

DISCUSSION

Tenders were publicly advertised on September 20, 2008 and closed on September 24, 2008. Bids were received from the following companies:

The scope of the work for this tender includes the supply, delivery, and installation of asphalt paving of approximately 4300 square metres of bus parking area. The tender also provides for the parking area's granular base, three stormwater catch basins, concrete curb, and sidewalk.

It is anticipated that work will commence within two weeks after tender award.

Based on the lowest tendered price of \$324,560.20, including net HST, funding is available in Capital Accounts CB100077, CBU00951, and CBX01057. The budget availability has been confirmed by Financial Services and the requisition has been adjusted in SAP.
