SUBJECT: Award - Tender No. 08-345, Removal of Existing, Supply &

Installation of Two (2) Hydraulic In-Ground Hoists at Metro Transit

Maintenance Facility - 200 Ilsley Ave.

ORIGIN

The Approved 2008/2009 Capital Budget

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that Council award Tender No. 08-345 to Carquest Canada Ltd. for a Total Tender Price of \$259,985.00 (net HST included) with funding from the Approved 2008/2009 Capital Budget No. CBX01034 - 200 Ilsley Avenue - Safety Upgrades, as outlined in the Budget Implications section of this report.

BACKGROUND

This is Phase Four of a multi-year program to replace a total of 14 aging, 28 year-old hydraulic inground bus hoists at 200 IIsley Avenue, with a new style lift system that addresses inherent safety and environmental concerns. The remaining 4 hoists will be replaced over the next two or three years, depending on availability of capital funding. The new style system incorporates integral, automatic locking safety legs, which eliminate the need for support jack stands, which are heavy and bulky to manoeuver into place each time a bus is lifted. The new style hoists will also reduce environmental concerns regarding oil spills, in that each of the two posts has a self-contained power unit within an under floor containment tank. This eliminates the need to bury hydraulic cylinders in the ground where they are exposed to moisture and corrosion, as well as long runs of hydraulic piping that could potentially leak.

DISCUSSION

Tender 08-345 was publicly advertised on Oct. 29 and Nov. 1, 2008 and closed on November 12, 2008. Two(2) Hoist Companies attended the mandatory pre-bid meeting with only one (1) tender submission received.

Note: Carquest Dartmouth Ltd. have partnered with MJS Holdings Ltd. for the installation of these two (2) Rotary Lift Systems. MJS Holdings Ltd. is the only authorized installer of Rotary Lift Systems in Atlantic Canada. This tender quotation is lower than pervious years' costs for similar work. Staff believe that re-tendering for this work would not result in any additional bids.
