SUBJECT: Award - Unit Price Tender No. 09-238, Thin Overlays Phase 1 - Various Locations

ORIGIN

The Approved Advanced 2009/10 Capital Budget.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that Council:

- 1. award Tender No. 09-238, Thin Overlays Phase 1 Various Locations to Lafarge Canada Inc. for a Total Tender Price of \$744,171.66 (net HST included) with funding from Capital Account No. CZU01082- Resurfacing Program as outlined in the Budget Implications section of this report.
- 2. approve an increase in the Gross Capital Budget of Capital Account CZU01082 -Resurfacing in the amount of \$100,000, funded from HROP GL2314 - Natural Gas Future Settlement Charges as per the budget implication section of this report to reflect the resurfacing of street(s) that currently have a natural gas pipeline from Heritage Gas.

BACKGROUND

The Approved Advanced 2009/10 Capital Budget includes funds for the thin overlay of streets at various locations in HRM, and the resurfacing of the Bedford Highway (Millview Avenue to Southgate Drive).

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DISCUSSION

Tenders were called on Feb. 25, 2009 and closed on March 13, 2009. Bids were received from the following companies:

The scope of work for this tender generally consists of the thin overlay of various streets in HRM, the resurfacing of Bedford Highway (Millview Avenue to Southgate Drive), asphalt curb replacement, manhole/catchbasin/valve adjustments, associated pavement marking reinstatements, and the striping of bike lanes where relevant.

It is anticipated construction will commence after the tender is awarded and as weather permits in the spring and will take five weeks to complete.

This is a **UNIT PRICE** contract and the cost will be dependent upon the actual quantities measured and approved by the HRM Project Manager.

There are no Local Improvement Charges associated with this work.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS

Based on the lowest tendered price of \$744,171.66 (net HST included), budget is available in the Approved Advanced 2009/10 Capital Budget from Capital Account No. CZU01082 - Resurfacing Program. The budget availability has been confirmed by Financial Services.

As a result of cost sharing from GL2314, the net cost to capital account CZU01082 is \$644,172. The balance of funds will be used to implement the remaining 2009/10 resurfacing projects approved by Council.
