ORIGIN

The Approved 2006/07 Capital Budget.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that Council award Tender No. 06-267, Sidewalk Renewals - West Region to Dexter Construction Company Limited for materials and services listed at the unit prices quoted for a Tender Price of \$397,375 including net HST from Capital Account No. CKU00783, Sidewalk Renewals and Capital Account No. CDG00490, Capital District - Urban Design Study, with funding authorized as per the Budget Implications Section of this report.

Bid Price

BACKGROUND

The Approved 2006/07 Capital Budget included funds for the replacement of concrete sidewalks because of their overall poor condition. The locations included in this tender meet or exceed the criteria for replacement.

DISCUSSION

Tenders were called on August 5, 2006 and closed on August 16, 2006. The following bids, exclusive of taxes, were received:

1.	Dexter Construction Company Limited	\$384,200.00
2.	Ocean Contractors Limited	\$400,030.00
3.	Basin Contracting Limited	\$522,000.00
4.	Lafarge Canada Inc.	\$589,425.00

The scope of work for this tender includes the renewal of concrete sidewalk, concrete curb and gutter, and reinstatement at the locations listed below. It also includes the installation of ornamental concrete pavers on two blocks of Hollis Street in keeping with HRM's continuing community improvement initiatives.

- Hollis Street (W) Prince Street to George Street
- Hollis Street (W) Bishop Street North 68 metres
- Fourth Street (S) Newton Avenue to Armcrescent East
- Rhuland Street (S) Lucknow Street to South Park Street
- Barrington Street (E) Super Store to Tim Horton's Driveway
- Young Avenue (E) Ogilvie Street to Harbourview Drive
- Mumford Road (N) Romans Avenue to Shopping Centre D/W

It is anticipated that work will commence within three weeks of the tender award and take approximately 6 weeks to complete.

This is a **UNIT PRICE** contract and the cost will be dependent upon the actual quantities measured and approved by the HRM Project Manager.

There are no Local Improvement Charges associated with this work.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS

Based on the lowest tendered price of \$384,200, plus net HST for a total project cost of \$397,375, funding is available in the Approved 2006/07 Capital Budget from Account No. CKU00783, Sidewalk Renewals and Account No. CDG00490, Capital District - Urban Design Study. The budget availability has been approved by Financial Services.
