Subject: Transit Service and Sunday Shopping

Request:

Please add the above item to the agenda for October 10, 2006

Reason:

With the recent announcement by the province that Sunday shopping will be permitted at all stores in Nova Scotia it can reasonably be expected that transit demands will go up on Sundays. Employees will need the ability to get to work on Sundays and residents will expect access at least equal to current Saturday service.

I request that transit report to council on their ability to handle increased demands for Sunday service as a result of this change, and further, what plans transit has now, or will develop to address this impending demand.

As Sunday shopping is expected to phase in beginning on the Sunday prior to the October 10, 2006 council meeting, it is evident that a quick response from transit is needed, and therefore I ask that the report be returned to council in no more than 2 weeks.
