**SUBJECT:** 2010/2011 Advanced Capital Budget Approval - 2<sup>nd</sup> Submission

#### **ORIGIN**

This report originates from staff.

#### RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that Halifax Regional Council approve \$16,400,000 of additional advanced funding of the Proposed 2010/2011 Capital Budget; as outlined in the Budget Implications section of this report.

#### **BACKGROUND**

On September 16, 2008, Council approved a change in the process for addressing early approval of a portion of the Capital Budget. The Capital Steering Committee, a committee of senior staff, was granted the authority to approve advanced funding where projects meet the criteria outlined in the Advanced Capital Project Funding Policy, included as Attachment A.

Advanced capital funding approval allows HRM to:

1. Take advantage of lower tendered prices from contractors by calling tenders in the early period of the construction season.

- 2. Take advantage of the full summer construction period to carry out projects which are sensitive to time and weather, such as working in the dry summer season to minimize environmental impacts, or working in school zones during the summer school break.
- 3. Tender projects which require a lengthy lead time to order equipment that will significantly delay the construction or installation of equipment.

Under this policy the Capital Steering Committee approved a list of projects which were contained in an information report to Council February 16<sup>th</sup>, 2010.

### **DISCUSSION**

This second approval is required because of critical time lines associated with several projects included in the 2010/11 Capital Budget.

Advanced capital is needed to ensure that projects can be completed within the scheduled construction season. It is important to note that all projects in this list are leveraged by external funding sources, and have critical needs for completion as follows:

The Capital Steering Committee had the authority to approve the first round of advanced capital budget, presented in February 16, 2010, but only Council may approve 2010/2011 proposed budget items after December 31 of the preceding year.

#### **BUDGET IMPLICATIONS**

The requested Advanced Capital Budget amount of \$16,400,000 would be the second request for advanced funding of the 2010/2011 Proposed Capital Budget. Funding for these projects will be

from a variety of sources including: Infrastructure Stimulus Program, RInC Program, debt, capital from operating, reserves and insurance proceeds.

All items in the table below are contained in the proposed 2010/2011capital budget and have been reviewed and approved by the Capital Steering Committee.

#### Attachment A

#### **Advanced Capital Project Funding Policy**

All capital projects using Advanced Funding must meet the following criteria:

- ♦ the project must be included in the proposed capital budget for the new fiscal year (Year 2 of the currently approved capital budget
- ♦ advanced funding for each project must not exceed 50% of the proposed capital budget for that project for the upcoming fiscal year
- project manager must provide justification to business unit director for the need for advance funding
- business unit director and capital steering committee must confirm that the project continues to be a part of the capital budget for the new fiscal year
- ♦ approval for advanced funding cannot be given prior to October 1<sup>st</sup> (i.e. 6 months before the commencement of the new fiscal year)
- ♦ no advanced capital requests can be approved after December 31<sup>st</sup>
- the normal procurement process for contracts still applies

Projects which have not been included in the previous year's capital plan and any requests for additional funding beyond the limits established above, must be approved by Council.
