# Background

**Planning Services** 

- On May 25, 2010, Council approved the 2010/11 Operating budget
- Recommendation: to increase processing fees for certain services in order to generate additional revenue
- To change HRM fees, Council needs to amend Administrative Order #15



### **Council Amendments**

**Planning Services** 

Council approved, in principle, two amendments:

i) Planning & Heritage applications fees be increased by 10%; and

#### Council Amendments

**Planning Services** 

- ii) Development Permits fees be established
  - a minimum fee of \$25 (sheds and accessory buildings)
  - \$250 fee for MICI development (Multi-Unit Residential, Industrial, Commercial or Institutional development)
  - \$100 fee for all others

(New Low Density Residential, Enclosed Additions, MICI renovations & lease hold improvements)



#### **Staff Amendments**

**Planning Services** 

Staff identified the need for additional amendments:

i) increase to the processing fee for variances from \$100 to \$500;

#### Why?

- reflect the amount of work and resources involved; and
- encourage more applicants to meet the requirements of the zone

- ii) include two existing administrative fees for:
  - Downtown Halifax Site Plan Applications and Pre-Applications; and
  - Zoning Confirmation Letters.
