Treaty Day October 1, 2010

WHEREAS every year, Nova Scotians recognize the rich history, proud culture and important contributions of the Mi'Kmaw people by celebrating Treaty Days; and

WHEREAS this summer's Grand Chief Membertou 400 celebrations at the Halifax Common generated renewed interest in, and appreciation for, Nova Scotia's First Nation's community; and

WHEREAS century-old treaties have created an enduring bond of friendship and respect with Nova Scotia's indigenous people.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, I, Mayor Peter Kelly, on behalf of Halifax Regional Council, do hereby proclaim October 1, 2010 as Mi'Kmaw Treaty Day in Halifax Regional Municipality.
