Conductive Education Day 2011 February 24, 2011

WHEREAS, Conductive Education, a unique teaching system developed more than 60 years ago in Hungary by Dr. András Peto to maximize the independence and mobility of people with neuro-motor disabilities resulting from strokes, cerebral palsy, multiple sclerosis, acquired brain injuries and Parkinson's disease; and

WHEREAS, Conductive Education recognizes the brain's ability to reorganize neural pathways based on new experiences and that, no matter how severe the disability, people can learn and improve when they are motivated; and

WHEREAS, Conductive Education has the potential to make a life-changing impact on the mobility and independence of almost 9 million people in North America; and

THEREFORE, I, Mayor Peter Kelly, on behalf of members of Halifax Regional Council do hereby proclaim February 24th as Conductive Education Day 2011 and encourage supporting this important program in our community.
