SUBJECT: Transportation Demand Management (TDM) Functional Plan

<u>ORIGIN</u>

Policy T-10 of the 2006 Regional Municipal Planning Strategy states, in part, that a TDM Functional Plan shall be prepared.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Transportation Standing Committee endorse the recommendation of the Regional Plan Advisory Committee in forwarding the TDM Functional Plan to Halifax Regional Council for its adoption in principle.

BACKGROUND

At its meeting of September 15, 2010, the Regional Plan Advisory Committee (RPAC) was provided a staff report accompanied by a presentation on the TDM Functional Plan. The Committee then passed a motion that Halifax Regional Council adopt, in principle, the Transportation Demand Management Functional Plan to guide the promotion and implementation of sustainable projects and programs within HRM.

DISCUSSION

The RPAC recommendation report to Regional Council, along with the TDM Functional Plan document, are attached to this report.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS

There are no immediate budget implications with the adoption of this report. Programs and projects recommended in the TDM Functional Plan will be brought before Regional Council for approval through the normal budgeting process.
