Conductive Education Day February 23, 2012


WHEREAS, Conductive Education, a unique teaching system developed more than 60 years ago to maximize the independence and mobility of people with neuro-motor disabilities resulting from strokes, cerebral palsy, multiple sclerosis, acquired brain injuries and Parkinson's disease; and

Conductive Education recognizes the brain's ability to reorganize neural pathways based on new experiences and that, no matter how severe the disability, people can learn and improve when they are motivated; and

Conductive Education has the potential to make a life-changing impact on the mobility and independence of almost 9 million people in North America; and

THEREFORE, I, Mayor Peter Kelly, on behalf of members of Halifax Regional Council do hereby proclaim February 23, 2012 as Conductive Education Day.
