This letter is to seek your approval for flypasts by a Royal Canadian Air Force Sea King helicopter over the MacDonald Bridge and Citadel Hill in Halifax in support of the 2013 Nova Scotia Boomer's Legacy Ride on 14 September 2013. 

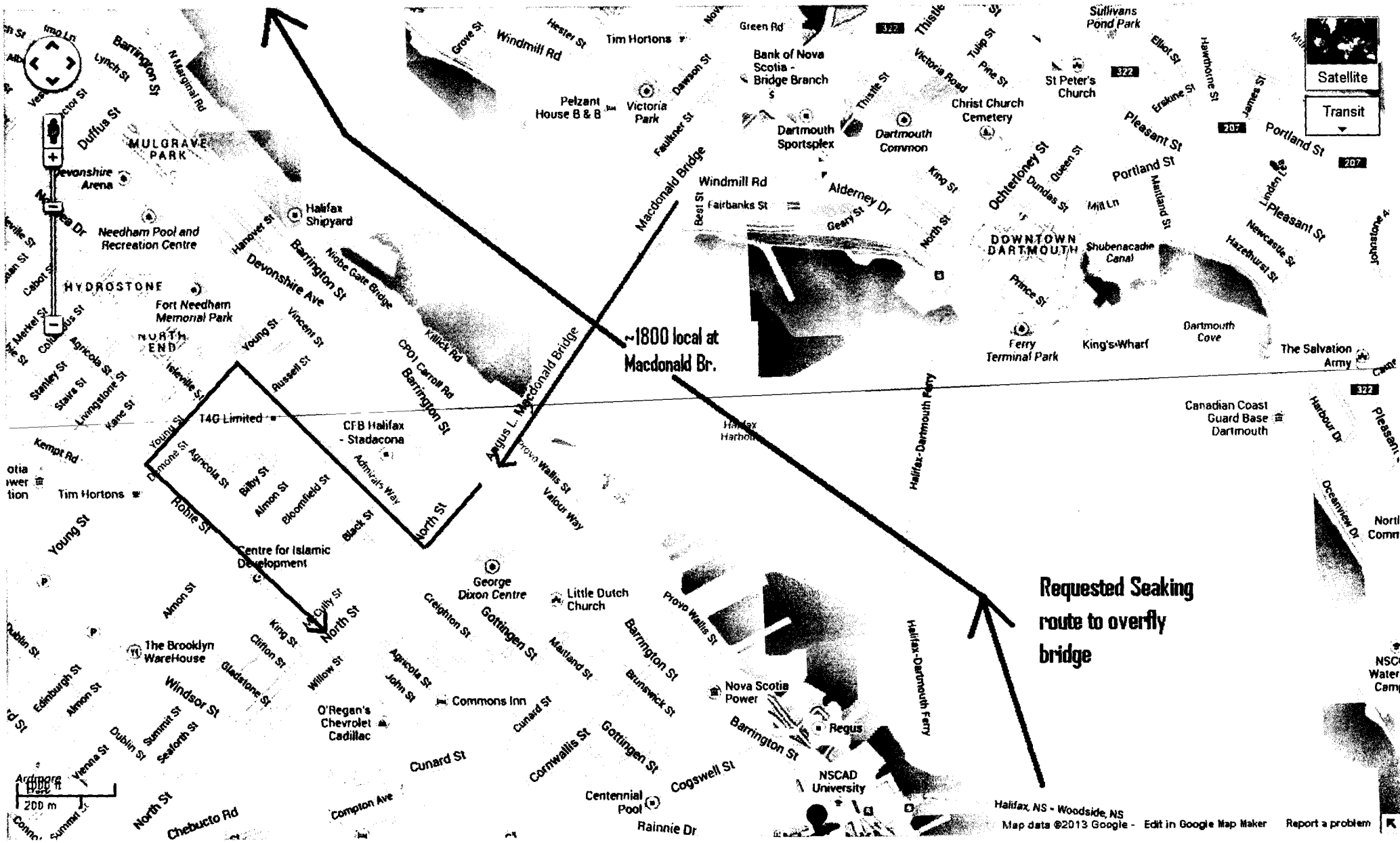
