<p>Motion for Council to Consider: That Halifax Regional Council requests the Mayor to write to the Federal Minister responsible for Canada Post on behalf of Council to request that Canada Post maintains the current levels of postal service in small and rural communities and continue to maintain residential door-to-door delivery in Canada.</p> <p>Reason:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Removal of this service will cause hardship for residents who have mobility challenges; particularly as our population ages- Continued concerns about the accessibility and maintenance of mailbox locations- Concerns that the consultation process with residents about these changes has not been adequate <p>Outcome Sought: Correspondence that will express the concerns of HRM residents.</p>
