SUBJECT:	Enabling Orders – Appointment of Members of Council to External Committees

<u>ORIGIN</u>

Motion of Regional Council October 21, 2014 in regard to Appointment of Members of Council to External Committees:

Reduce the number of Councillors appointed to the Regional Library Board and the Halifax-Dartmouth Bridge Commission Board to two (2) Council members from four (4) and, with respect to the Regional Library, work with the Provincial Government to make appropriate changes to the relevant agreements.

That staff be directed to draft an Administrative Order to implement recommendation #2 as set out in Table 1 and Table 2 of the supplementary staff report dated September 19, 2014.

LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY

Halifax Regional Municipal Charter Section 20, which provides that Council may make policies providing for committees and conferring powers and duties upon them and make appointments to such committees.

Municipal Conflict of Interest Act Section 5 (1) (f) & (h) which states;

5(1) This Act does not apply to any interest in any matter that a member may have....

(f) by reason of being eligible for appointment, or having been appointed, by the council to a local board;

(h) by reason of having been appointed by the council or local board to a board, committee or other body;

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that Halifax Regional Council:

 Adopt the enabling Administrative Order No. 2014-017-GOV Respecting the Appointment of Members of Council to External Boards, Committees and Commissions as directed by motion of Regional Council on October 21, 2014, provided as Attachment 1 of this report; and

2) Authorize the Mayor and Municipal Clerk to execute the amending agreement between the Province and the Municipality providing for the changes in composition of the Halifax Regional Library Board as directed by Regional Council on October 21, 2014, provided as Attachment 2 of this report.

BACKGROUND

The Executive Standing Committee undertook a review of governance as directed by Regional Council and reported to Council with recommendations regarding internal and standing committees on May 13, 2014 and the appointment of members of Council to external committees on October 21, 2014.

DISCUSSION

On October 21, 2014 Halifax Regional Council adopted the recommendations of the Executive Committee in regard to the Appointment of Members of Council to External Boards and Committees.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NUMBER 2014-017-GOV RESPECTING THE APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS OF COUNCIL TO EXTERNAL BOARDS, COMMITTEES OR COMMISSIONS

BE IT RESOLVED AS AN ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER of the Council of the

Halifax Regional Municipality under the authority of the Halifax Regional Municipality Charter, as follows:

Short Title

1. This Administrative Order may be known as the Appointments of Members of Council to External Bodies Administrative Order.

Purposes

2. The purposes of this Administrative Order are to determine

(a) when Council may appoint or refuse to appoint Members to external bodies;

(b) which external bodies Council may consider appointing Members;

(c) the reporting requirements regarding other bodies on which Members may choose to serve without the appointment of Council.

Interpretation

3. In this Administrative Order,

(a) "CAO" means the Chief Administrative Officer of the Municipality;

(b) "Clerk" means the Clerk of the Municipality, and includes a person acting under the direction or supervision of the Clerk;

(c) "Council" means the Council of the Municipality;

(d) "Community Council" means the council of a community established pursuant to the *Halifax Regional Municipality Charter*,

(e) "External body" means any board, commission, committee, body or local authority of any kind established to exercise or exercising any power or authority under any general or special Act with respect to any of the affairs or purposes of a municipality or parts thereof or of two or more municipalities or parts thereof, or to which a municipality or municipalities are required to provide funds, and includes a school board pursuant to the *School Boards Act*;

(f) "Member"" means a member of Council, including the Mayor; and

(g) "Municipality" means the Halifax Regional Municipality.

Roles and Responsibilities

4. (1) Only Council may appoint Members to external bodies.

(2) Any appointments by Council of Members to external bodies shall be made pursuant to section 9 or 10 of this *Administrative Order*.

5. Council may delegate, by Administrative Order, the nominating authority for appointments of Members to external bodies to a Standing Committee of Council or a Community Council.

6. The Clerk shall keep a list of the appointments of Members to external bodies made by Council.

7. A Member who sits on an external body that has not been appointed to such body by Council shall provide the name of that external body to the Clerk.

External Bodies

8. Council shall not be bound by the by-laws or articles of incorporation adopted by an external body providing for the appointment of a Member to such body.

Council Appointments Required By Enactment, By-law or Agreement

9. (1) Council may appoint Members to external bodies

(i) in accordance with any enactment of the Government of Canada or Province of Nova Scotia;

(ii) in accordance with the By-laws of the Municipality or an agreement to which the Municipality is a party; or

(iii) as otherwise directed by Council.

(2) An external body Council considers meets the purpose of subsection 1 of this section shall be named in Appendix A.

(3) Council may amend Appendix A to add or remove the name of an external body.

External Bodies by Council Appointment

10. (1) Council may appoint Members to bodies, including external bodies, which in the opinion of Council,:

- (a) are Regional in scope;
- (b) affect or may affect a municipal interest; or

(c) are community organizations with a mandate to provide an alternative service delivery in respect of municipal property on behalf of the Municipality, and to which the Municipality is the primary funder.

(2) An external body Council considers meets the purpose of subsection 1 of this section shall be named in Appendix B.

(3) Council may amend Appendix B to add or remove the name of an external body.

External Bodies Without Council Appointment

11. (1) A Member who sits on a body that has not been appointed to such body by Council shall advise the Clerk of the name of the body on which he or she sits.

(2) The Clerk, in accordance with the *Municipal Conflict of Interest Act*, shall retain a list of the names of the bodies provided by the Members pursuant to subsection 1 of this section and the list shall indicate the name of the Member and the name of the body provided.

(3) The Clerk shall retain the list created pursuant to subsection 2 of this section in the Office of the Municipal Clerk as a public record.

(4) The Clerk shall provide the list annually to the Members for their review and the Members shall advise the Clerk of any errors or omissions on such list.

THIS AMENDING AGREEMENT made in duplicate this _____ day of _____, 2014.

BETWEEN:

HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN IN RIGHT OF THE PROVINCE OF NOVA SCOTIA, as represented by the Minister of Communities, Culture and Heritage (the "Province")

-and-

HALIFAX REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY, a body corporate, incorporated pursuant to the laws of Nova Scotia (the "Municipality")

WHEREAS the Province and the Municipality signed an Agreement on the 1st day of April, 1996 (the "Original Agreement") relating to the establishment of the Halifax Regional Library Board (the "Board");

AND WHEREAS the Province and the Municipality wish to amend the Original Agreement with respect to municipal membership on the Board;

NOW THEREFORE in consideration of the sum of \$1.00 and the mutual covenants contained in this Amending Agreement, the Province and the Municipality agree as follows:

1. Clause 1(1)(c) of the Original Agreement is deleted and replaced with the following:

"(c) eight persons appointed by the Council of the Municipality pursuant to clause 10(2)(c) of the *Act* as follows:

- (i) two councillors of the Municipality, and
- (ii) six citizens of the Municipality."
- 2. All other provisions of the Original Agreement remain in effect unamended.
