### **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that Council award Tender No. 06-226, Portland Hills Transit Terminal Parking Lot Expansion - East Region, to Ocean Contractors Limited for materials and services listed at the unit prices quoted for a Tender Price of \$129,183 including net HST from the Approved Advanced 2006/07 Capital Budget Account No. CB200428, Transit Terminal Upgrade & Expansion, with funding authorized as per the Budget Implications section of this report.

# **BACKGROUND**

The Approved Advanced 2006/07 Capital Budget includes funds for the expansion and or upgrades to existing transit terminals within the municipality.

#### **DISCUSSION**

Tenders for this project were called on March 8, 2006 and closed on March 22, 2006. The following bids, exclusive of taxes, were received:

Due to the overwhelming success of the new MetroLink transit service, the existing parking lot at the Portland Hills Transit Terminal is at capacity and in need of expansion. The scope of work for this tender generally consists of a new asphalt parking lot including drainage, lighting and sodding.

It is anticipated that work will commence when weather permits in the spring of 2006 and take 5 weeks to complete.

This is a **UNIT PRICE** contract and the cost will be dependent upon the actual quantities measured and approved by the HRM Project Manager.

There are no Local Improvement Charges associated with this work.

### **BUDGET IMPLICATIONS**

Based on the lowest tendered price of \$124,900.00, plus net HST, for a total project cost of \$129,183, funding is available in Approved Advanced 2006/07 Capital Budget from Account No. CB200428, Transit Terminal Upgrade & Expansion. The budget availability has been approved by Financial Services.
