The 2006/2007 Advanced Approved Capital Budget.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that Council award Tender No. 06-061, for Four(4) 2006 4-Wheel Drive Litter Vacuums to Saunders Equipment Limited for a Tender Price of \$239,989.00(net HST included) with funding from Capital Account No. CVD00413 - General Fleet Replacement, as outlined in the Budget Implications section of this report.

BACKGROUND

Tender # 06-061 - Four(4) new 2006 4-Wheel Drive Litter Vacuums. Tenders were received from the following company:

Note: Several equipment supplies received tenders, however they were unable to meet the specified requirement for 4-wheel drive units.

DISCUSSION

The decision to request 4-wheel drive litter vacuums was two-fold. First, they would provide an additional safety component to the operator which would make the units less susceptible to roll overs and lower the number of situations of getting stuck on wet grass or in ditches. Secondly, they add the versatility of being able to utilize these units on road shoulders, wide ditches and rough terrain and not solely on sidewalks and paved roads.

Saunders Equipment will be supplying 2006 Madvac 4-Wheel Drive Litter Vacuums.. These units will be replacing unit # B39 and SE323 used by Transportation and Public Works.

Delivery is scheduled for September 29, 2006.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS
