## **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that Council award Tender No. 06-062, for Three(3) 2007 4x4 Crewcab and Chassis with Service Body to Chebucto Ford Sales for a Tender Price of \$153,248.00 (net HST included) with funding from Capital Account No. CVJ00894 and CVJ00895 as outlined in the Budget Implications section of this report.

# BACKGROUND

Tender # 06-062 - Three(3) 2007 4x4 Crewcab and Chassis Trucks with Service Body. Tenders were received from the following companies:

Note: A third bid received from Steele Ford Lincoln was rejected as it did not meet the front axle requirements for these trucks.

#### **DISCUSSION**

Chebucto Ford Sales will be supplying 2007 Ford F-350 4x4 Crewcab and Chassis with Service Body. The new light rescue units will be replacing units # 85-202U, 85-196U and 93-232U used by the Halifax Regional Fire and Emergency Service.

Delivery is scheduled for August 31, 2006.
