Surplus Right of Way - Rocky Hill Road, Halifax

#### **ORIGIN**

This report originates from HRM's capital works program involving a recent upgrade to Rocky Hill Road, Halifax and an approved Agreement of Purchase and Sale for the conveyance of surplus right of way land to the property owners at Civic 4 Rocky Hill Road.

#### **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that Council:

1. close the surplus portion of Rocky Hill Road Right of Way, Halifax, pursuant to HRM Administrative Order SC-42 and as shown on Attachment "A" to conclude the sale of the subject lands.

#### **BACKGROUND**

The Municipality's Transportation and Public Works (TPW) upgraded Rocky Hill Road and Wren Street during the months of July and August, 2005. During the design stage, TPW identified a need for additional frontage lands from five (5) property owners on Rocky Hill Road and a small portion at the corner of Forest Hill Drive and Wren Street (34 Forest Hill Drive).

The streetline adjustment at 4 Rocky Hill Road resulted in two parcels of land, identified as Parcel A1 (64.5 sq. ft.) and Parcel A2 (351 sq. ft.) on Attachment A, as surplus. These lands total 415.5 sq. ft.

#### **DISCUSSION**

In order to finalize conveyance of Parcels A1 and A2 to 4 Rocky Hill Road, it is recommended that Council approve closure of the subject Right of Way lands, pursuant to Part 12 of the Municipal Government Act. Section 315 (1A) of the Act informs Council's decision with respect to this matter and does not require Council to hold a public hearing:

- Notwithstanding subsection (1), where a street or part of a street is being altered, improved or redesigned, part of that street may be closed without holding a public hearing under subsection (1) if
  - (a) the part of the street that remains open
    - (i) is open to vehicular and pedestrian traffic, and
    - (ii) meets all the municipal standards; and
  - (b) the part of the street that is closed
    - (i) is determined by the engineer to be surplus, and
    - (ii) is worth less than fifty thousand dollars.

The surplus street right of way closure is as follows.



#### RESPECTING CLOSURE OF A PORTION OF

#### ROCKY HILL ROAD, HALIFAX

Whereas Rocky Hill Road, a public street in Halifax Regional Municipality is being altered, improved and redesigned, and as a result thereof part of that street right of way more particularly described in Attachment "A" is proposed to be closed;

And Whereas Rocky Hill Road will remain open to vehicular and pedestrian traffic and will meet all the municipal standards.

And Whereas the Engineer of Halifax Regional Municipality has determined that the portions of the street more particularly described in Attachment "A" are surplus to the needs of Halifax Regional Municipality'

And Whereas the portions of the street more particularly described in Attachment "A" is worth \$1, being less than fifty thousand dollars.

And Whereas pursuant to Section 315 (1A) of the *Municipal Government Act* the portions of Rocky Hill Road more particularly described in Attachment "A" may be closed without holding a public hearing
