

### INFORMATION REPORT

#### ORIGIN

- April 5, 2005 Information Report on Timberlea, Lakeside, Beechville Sewage Treatment Plant Capacity;
- April 12, 2005 motion by Regional Council for a report on options to treat wastewater from undeveloped lands in the Timberlea, Lakeside and Beechville Service Boundary;
- June 28, 2005 Supplementary Report was deleted from the July 5, 2005 Regional Council agenda;
- August 9, 2005 - Request by Councillor Rankin for staff to prepare a supplementary report for the September 6<sup>th</sup> meeting of Council to provide clarification on a number of points raised as a result of an Information Report dated July 27, 2005.

#### BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

An information report was tabled with Regional Council on August 9, 2005 which indicated that staff has agreed to allow Westgate time to explore further options, keeping in mind that other property owners are in the same circumstance. Councillor Rankin submitted a list of questions which he asked staff to provide clarification on for the September 6, 2005 Council meeting.

Staff is unable to meet the requested deadline of September 6, 2005, due to vacations. A supplementary report responding to the questions will be available for the September 20, 2005 meeting of Council.


