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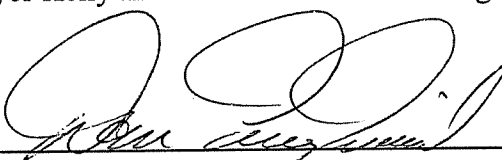

SUBJECT: Capital Budget Increase - Cost Sharing for Capital District Projects

ORIGIN

In accordance with the Multi-Year Financial Strategy, any increases to the capital budget must be approved by Council.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that:

Council approve an increase in the Gross Capital Budget to Capital Account No. CDG00271 Downtown Streetscape Program by \$10,835 with no change to the Net Budget, to reflect cost sharing for Capital District Projects, as per the Background section of this report.

BACKGROUND

Each year during the capital budget preparation, staff identifies and incorporates all known cost sharing opportunities in the capital projects submission. However, after the budget approval additional opportunities do become available by leveraging funding from other levels of government and the private sector.

When additional funding is received, after the approval of the capital budget, staff is required to obtain Council's approval for any increases to the Capital Budget, in accordance with the Multi Year Financial Strategy.

DISCUSSION

The table below outlines two projects within the Capital District where funding was leveraged from external parties, as well as the funding sources and the capital budget account numbers impacted by the requested increase. This cost sharing will allow for the installation of tree lighting within Victoria Park and will reimburse the HRM for a portion of the costs of installing the historic lion sculptures in the Granville Mall.

Council could chose not to approve the increase. This is not recommended as the potential cost sharing would be lost.

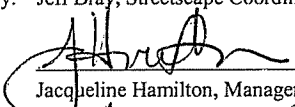

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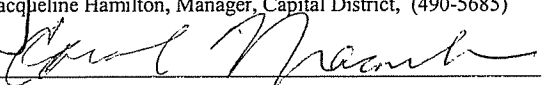

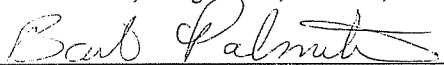
