

## CAR FREE DAY APRIL 25, 2002

WHEREAS	Transportation accounts for 27% of Nova Scotia's greenhouse gas emissions; and
WHEREAS	Air pollution increases the chance of asthma attacks and respiratory infections, especially for the very young, elderly and those with existing respiratory disease; and
WHEREAS	Automobile emissions are estimated to cost the Nova Scotia health care system well over \$200 million per year; and
WHEREAS	Infrastructure of cars consumes farmland, wilderness, and valuable urban space;
WHEREAS	The majority of car trips in North America are 5 kms and under, and these same trips can often be done by walking, cycling, riding the bus or car pooling.
