

ORIGIN

1. Motion of Council, July 2, 2002, to establish an interim Board of Directors for the "Downtown Dartmouth Development Corporation".
2. Report to Regional Council at the July 9, 2002 session - "2002/03 Area Rates for Business Improvement Districts" (report dated June 28, 2002).

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

At the July 2nd Council session, the interim Board of Directors was approved, with reference made to the "Downtown Dartmouth Development Corporation". On July 9th, Council approved an area rate for the Business Improvement District referred to as "Downtown Dartmouth".

The purpose of this report is to clarify that the correct terminology for this group and the area it represents, as approved by the Registry of Joint Stock Companies, is the "Capital District East Business Commission" and the "Capital District East Business Improvement District".


