SUBJECT: Tender #03-060 - One New Rescue Pumper

ORIGIN

The Halifax Regional Municipality publically advertised tenders for One (1) Model New Rescue Pumper for use within the Halifax Regional Fire and Emergency Service.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that:

1. Council authorize the award of Tender #03-060 for the purchase of one (1) 2004 American LaFrance Rescue Pumper to Nova Enterprises Limited at a cost of \$433,124.17 (net HST included) with funding from Capital Account CVJ00223, Apparatus Replacement, as outlined in the Budget Implications section of this report.

BACKGROUND

Tender # 03-060 - One(1) New Rescue Pumper. A total of nine (9) companies received tender documents with three (3) responding.

DISCUSSION

Nova Enterprises Limited will be supplying one(1) Model 2004 American LaFrance Rescue Pumper to be utilized at the Halifax Regional Fire and Emergency Services Woodside Station. The new Rescue Pumper will be replacing an existing unit from the Woodside Station. Upon receipt of the new Rescue Pumper the existing unit will be assigned to the Fire Service Vehicle Reserve.

Delivery is scheduled for May 15th, 2004.
