ANNUAL REPORT

ORIGIN

Section 27(1) of the HRM Charter states:

A community council shall hold an annual public meeting in the community in each year to report to the public concerning its activities and to receive the views of the public respecting all matters within its mandate.

BACKGROUND

An annual public meeting in the community is required as per Section 27(1) of the HRM Charter.

DISCUSSION

The Western Region Community Council was established by Halifax Regional Council on February 20, 2001, as per Administrative Order 26 which came into effect on April 1, 2011. The Western Region Community Council covers the area of the Halifax Regional Municipality that on the 2nd day of November 2004 was included in polling district 22, Timberlea -Prospect, polling district 23, Hammonds Plains - St. Margarets WITH THE EXCEPTION OF that portion of polling district 23 that falls within the Beaver Bank, Hammonds Plains, Upper Sackville Municipal Planning Strategy, and; that part of polling district 18, Spryfield - Herring Cove which was situated within the boundaries of the former Halifax County Municipality prior to April 1, 1996,

Community Councils are governed by the Municipal Government Act, HRM Charter, the Rules of Procedure for Halifax Regional Council as outlined in Administrative Order 1, and the Western Region Community Council Rules of Procedure.

Western Region Community Council met fourteen (14) times between April 2011 and March 31, 2012, including four (4) special meetings.
