

Index to City of Halifax Council Minutes

Feb. 17, 1888 – Sept. 22, 1890

This index was created by the City Clerk in the 1890s. Note that the entries are not that helpful or intuitive. They are listed chronologically under “Appointments” “Letters”, “Opinions”, “Petitions” “Reports”, “Resolutions”; many letters of the alphabet have no entries). Browsing through the entire index is the most thorough way of accessing the minutes.

Entries refer to the page number in the subsequent minutes (see number in the upper corner on each page).

Do not scan blank pages

The alpha-tab on the left-hand side does not need to be scanned (the letter has been put at the top of each page).

For the volume:

Be sure to capture the entire page:

- the “headlines” in the margins are crucial, but very close to the binding.
