substitute a 24 inch therefor, and further, Resolved that
if the Engineer shall think favourably thereof the City Council

The Committee of City Property met this day present Aldermen Lounds, Roome, Conway, Barnstead and the Chairman.

A communication from the Crown Land Office to His Worship the Mayor dated 23 Decr. 1859 having been referred to this Committee to report upon.

Have to report as follows. The Chairman of this Committee upon enquiry at the Crown Land Office was informed that the application from J & O Connor for a Grant of the Water Lot adjoining their property near H.M. Ordnance, had been withdrawn, and the passing of a Grant to John Tobin Esq for a Water Lot between Bennetts & Staynes Wharves. Would not be recommended by the Department without the concurrence of the owners of the adjoining properties.

His Honor the Recorder having by a Resolution of the City Council been requested to prepare an Act to enable the Council to borrow the sum £2,000 on the credit of the City - for the purpose of erecting a Brick or Stone Building on the Market Slip property. Immediately complied with the request and furnished your Committee with the draft of a Bill for that object which we herewith submit to the Council for their approval - the same having met the approval of this Committee, they therefore recommend that it be adopted by the Council, fairly engrossed and transmitted to the Legislature without delay.

The Chairman brought to the Notice of the Committee that the sum of £10,18.9 had been deposited at the Crown Land Office with an application for a Grant of the Pock Wock Lake on the 28th July 1860 and that the Government had declined to allow the said Grant.
