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1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. at the Nauss Room, Lebrun Centre, Bedford.

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The Committee members made introductions around the table.

2. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES - March 4, 2009

5. REPORTS

5.1 Case 01216: Amending Agreements - 950 Bedford Highway, Bedford

A report dated March 17, 2009, on the above noted, was before the Committee.

Mr. Darrell Joudrey, Planner, presented the above noted report to the Committee.

The following is a correction changed in the report: i2) the sign shall not exceed 15 feet.

Following the amendment presentation, the following concerns were brought forward by the Committee and addressed by staff:

- it is anticipated the only tree to be removed is the damaged tree on the property
- once the tree is removed, will its chips be left on site
- there is a possibility that missing trees could be replanted
- site presently has the minimal amount of parking
- there may be an oil grit separator already on the site
- concern was raised that an illuminated sign may disturb adjacent residential properties, this point was not raised at the public information meeting
- it was requested that the light be turned off overnight
- how is the light energized

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Ms. Lowther advised that she is against the proposal. She stated that there is enough signage for the area, adding that there is a large sign as part of the property on the Bedford Highway. She stated that too much signage is unattractive in an area. She noted that in 1993 when the development agreement was signed for the property, the building was designed to have a certain character; more signs only take away from that character. She raised concern that there will be more trees than anticipated removed to accommodate the five foot setback. She advised that signage in this spot would be dangerous to traffic, as sightlines from the road and driveways will be impacted.

MOVED BY Mr. Zobaric, seconded by Councillor Harvey, that North West Planning Advisory Committee recommend that North West Community Council:

- 1. Approve the proposed Amending Agreement which deals with the nonsubstantive matter of a second sign, as set out in Attachment A of the report dated March 17, 2009;
- 2. Give Notice of Motion to consider the proposed amending agreement which deals with the substantive matters of further intrusion into the natural wooded area along the Hammonds Plains Road side of the property, as set out in Attachment B of the report dated March 17, 2009, and schedule a public hearing;
- 3. Approve the proposed amending agreement for the substantive matter as set out in Attachment B of the report dated March 17, 2009;
- 4. Require the proposed amending agreements be signed an delivered within 120 days, or any extension thereof granted by North West Community Council on request of the applicant, from the date of final approval of said agreement by North West Community Council, and any other bodies as necessary, whichever is later, including any appeal periods. Otherwise this approval shall be void and any obligations arising hereunder shall be at an end.
- 5. Preparation of a supplementary report to North West Community Council at the time of the public hearing addressing the following issues:
 - a) How many trees have to removed to install the sign
 - b) Can HRM require that new trees be planted to replace any trees removed from the site
 - c) Can HRM require that the chips from any trees being removed be left on the site
 - d) Is there an oil grit separator on the site
 - e) Can HRM require the owner to turn off the sign at night
 - f) How will the sign be energized, ie., how will the power get to it and will trees have to be removed to get power to the sign.
