## PROPOSAL INFORMATION: Case 18686

**APPLICANT:** Halifax Regional Municipality

**REQUEST:** HRM has initiated a planning process to consider extending the water service boundary from Lucasville Road to the new Highway 101 interchange (Margeson Drive) adjacent to McCabe Lake North.

**PROPOSAL:** The boundary extension would serve to permit central potable water services along a service road near to the new 101 interchange. If approved the central water service extension could potentially service lands at the 101 interchange and the McCabe Lake North Subdivision development (currently planned for approximately 357 lots).

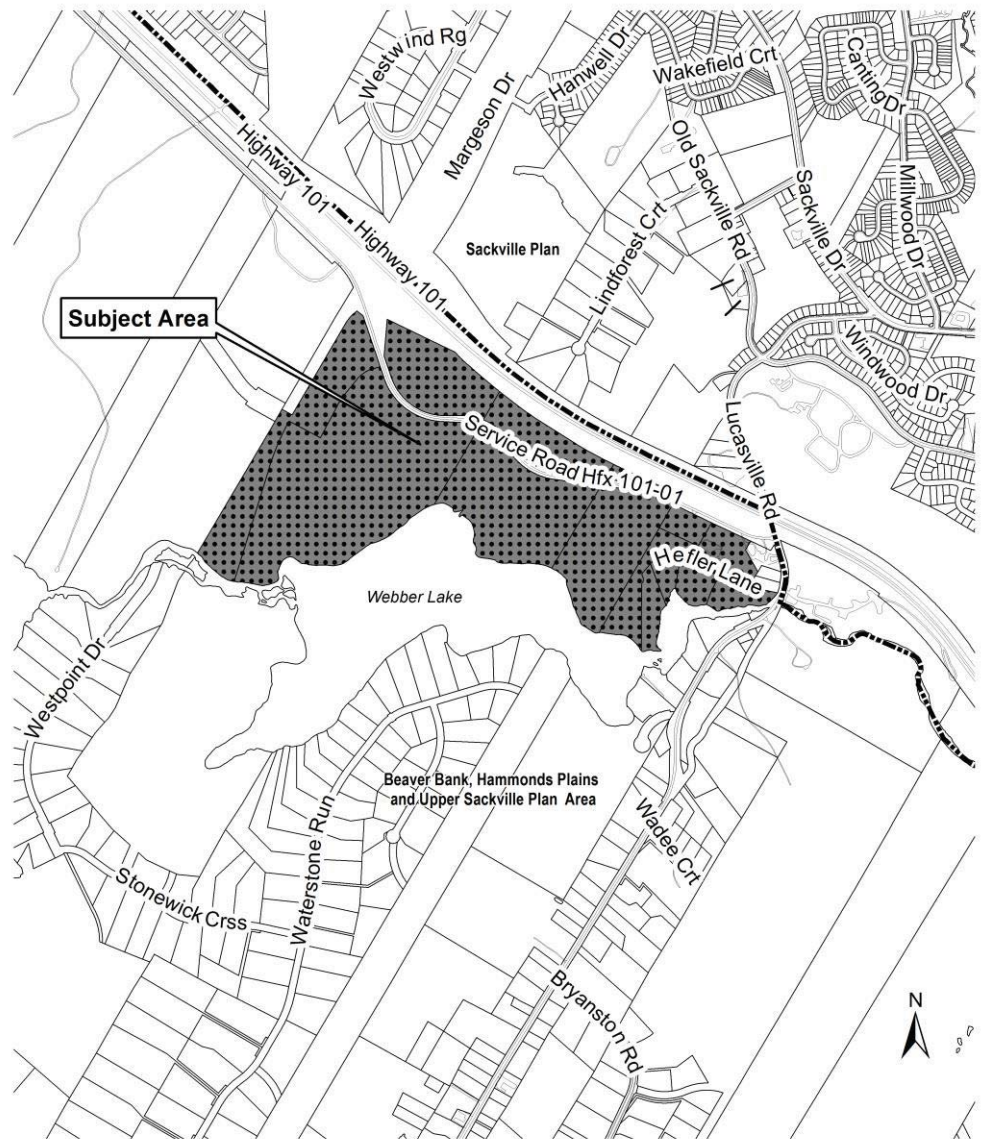
