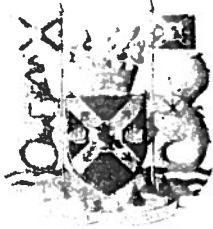

**RE: Circumferential Highway Maintenance**

At the Halifax Regional Council meeting held on February 5, 2013, the following motion was passed by Regional Council:

*Halifax Regional Council support a letter being sent from Mayor Mike Savage on behalf of Halifax Regional Council to contact the Province of Nova Scotia, in particular the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure Renewal, and request consistent maintenance of the area at the entrance of Lakeshore Park Terrace/Lakemist Court in Dartmouth, on the Circumferential Highway, particularly with regard to the overgrown grass and weeds and the clean-up of a substantial amount of litter. The motion was MOVED by Councillor Fisher and seconded by Councillor Nicoll.*

It was noted that the Nova Scotia Department of Transportation and Infrastructure Renewal had cleaned up a portion of the Circumferential Highway during the summer, but ignored the adjacent community side. On the adjacent side there were weeds growing three or four feet tall with a substantial amount of litter. It is the hope of Regional Council that the province will consider cleaning the adjacent community side when they are conducting their scheduled maintenance work.
