Our theme for the month of September is "Operation School Safety Zone and Crosswalk Safety".

During the month of August, Traffic officers participated in the following events:

- August 9, 10, 11, Traffic members assisted with a major vehicle compliance check point in concert with Service Nova Scotia inspectors at three locations in Metro in an effort to identify any vehicle in need of inspection for safety compliance. The three locations were Akerly Blvd., Prospect Rd. and Hollis St., resulting in a total of 76 SOTs being issued for various offences, 15 inspections leading to 13 rejections.
- August 13, Traffic members attended the Northern Lights Festival in Uniacke Square with the Village Constables.
- August 17, Traffic officers continued to assist members from the IWK Safety Link Program with by conducting a road check point on Pleasant St. in Dartmouth in an effort to identify vehicles with child restraint systems in need of adjustment or upgrade.
