Environmental Scan of 2012 1st Quarter

Total District Criminal Code Offences/Drugs

<u>Total Criminal Code</u> offences in the first quarter of 2012 show a **decrease** of 131 or by - 9.44% compared to the first quarter in 2011.

<u>Drugs</u> for the first quarter of 2012 *increased* by 45 or by 40.18% compared to the first quarter of 2011.

In the first quarter <u>Property offences</u> count for 52% of Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against <u>Persons</u> account for 14% and <u>Other Criminal Code</u> offences account for 31%.

First Quarter comparison between 2011 and 2012:

Property Crimes

Overall Property Crime decreased by 33 or -4.77%.

Stolen Motor Vehicles decreased by 5 or 12.82%.

Break and Enters decreased by 15 or -11.63%.

Fraud incidents *increased* by 21 or 44.68%.

Violent Crimes

Overall Violent Crime decreased by 3 or -1.70%.

Robberies increased by 3 or 30%.

Homicides *increased* by 1 or 100%.

Attempted Murders **decreased** by 1 or -33.33%.

Assaults **decreased** by 8 or -4.97%.

Assaults accounted for 88% of reported violent crimes in the first quarter of 2012.

Other Criminal Code

Includes prostitution, gaming/betting, offensive weapons, and other criminal code offences (i.e. arson, property damage, indecent acts, counterfeiting currency etc.)

Offensive Weapons increased by 6 in the first quarter of 2012 or by 26.09%.

Prostitution offences remained the same at 1.

Assaults - Break & Enter - Theft Under January - March 2011/12

Assaults

Assaults Level 1 accounted for 60% of the total <u>Assaults</u> in the 1st quarter of 2012 compared to 66% in 2011 and experienced a 12% **decrease** in 2012 over the same period last year.

Assault with a Weapon Causing Bodily Harm accounted for 17% of the total <u>Assaults</u> in 2012 compared to 18% in 2011 and experienced a 10% **decrease** over the same period last year.

All forms of Sexual Assaults combined accounted for 17% of the total <u>Assaults</u> in 2012 compared to 9% in 2011 and experienced a 80% *increase* over the same period last year.

Robberies accounted for 8% of the total <u>Persons Crime</u> in the 1ST quarter of 2012 compared to 6% in 2011 and experienced a 30% *increase* in 2012 over the same period last year.

Break & Enter

Break & Enter (Residence) accounted for 59% of the total <u>Break & Enters</u> in the 1st quarter of 2012 compared to 58% in 2011 and experienced a 11% **decrease** in 2012 over the same period last year.

Break & Enter (Other) accounted for 27% of the total <u>Break & Enters</u> in the 1st quarter of 2012 compared to 14% in 2011 and experienced a 72% *increase* over the same period last year.

Break & Enter (Business) accounted for 14% of the total <u>Break & Enters</u> in the 1st quarter 2012 compared to 25% in 2011 and experienced a 50% **decrease** in 2012 over the same period last year.

Theft Under \$5,000 accounted for 67% of the total <u>Theft Under \$5,000</u> in the 1st quarter 2012 compared to 62% in 2011 and experienced a 2% *increase* in 2012 over the same period last year.

Theft From Motor Vehicle accounted for 32% of the total <u>Theft Under \$5,000</u> in the 1st quarter 2012 compared to 37% in 2011 and experienced a 18% **decrease** over the same period last year.

Possession of Stolen Goods experienced a 53% **decrease** in the 1st quarter 2012 over the same period last year.





