HRM Policing Services Environmental Scan of Preliminary Crime Statistics 2nd Quarter 2012

Total City Wide Criminal Code Offences/Drugs

Total Criminal Code offences reported in the second quarter of 2012 show a decrease of 789 reported offences or a % of change = -11.54 % compared to the second quarter of 2011. Drugs for second quarter 2012 show an increase of 5 offences or a % of change = +1.52 % compared to second quarter 2011.

Property offences account for 50% of reported C.C.C. offences, while crimes against persons account for 13% and other criminal code offences account for 36%.

Property Crinies

Property crime shows a decrease of -56 reported offences or -12.90% of change.

Stolen motor vehicles decreased by -46 offences or a % of change = -27.38%.

Break and Enters decreased by -56 offences or a % of change = -12.90%.

Fraud decreased by -8 offences or a % of change = -2.49%.

Violent Crimes

Violent crimes has experienced a decrease in the second quarter of 2012 compared to 2011 by -194 offences or a % of change = -20.36%.

Robberies decreased by -37 offences or a % of change = -35.58%.

Homicides decreased by -1 incident in 2012 compared to the second quarter of 2011 or -16.67%.

Attempt murders decreased by -4 offences, going from 10 in the second quarter of 2011 to 6 in 2012 or a decrease of -40%.

Assaults decreased by -151 offences or % of change = -18.39%. Assaults account for 88% of violent crimes in the second quarter of 2012.

Other Criminal Code

Includes prostitution, gaming/betting, offensive weapons, and other criminal code offences (arson, property damage, indecent acts, counterfeiting, etc) has decreased by -218 or by -9.14%

Prostitution offences decreased by -12 offences in the second quarter of 2012 over 2011 or -75%.

Please note offences such as drug and prostitution are sensitive to directed enforcement and detection.

Environmental Scan of 2012 2nd Quarter

Total District Criminal Code Offences/Drugs

<u>Total Criminal Code</u> offences in the second quarter of 2012 show a **decrease** of 133 or by -7.56% compared to the second quarter in 2011.

<u>Drugs</u> for the second quarter of 2012 *increased* by 24r by 18.46 compared to the second quarter of 2011.

In the second quarter <u>Property offences</u> count for 52% of Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against <u>Persons</u> account for 11% and <u>Other Criminal Code</u> offences account for 35%.

Second Quarter comparison between 2011 and 2012:

Property Crimes

Overall Property Crime decreased by 42 or -4.75%.

Stolen Motor Vehicles remained the same at 37.

Break and Enters **decreased** by 1 or -.71%.

Fraud incidents increased by 10 or 16.13%.

Violent Crimes

Overall Violent Crime decreased by 34 or -15.74%.

Robberies decreased by 9 or -56.25%.

Homicides decreased by 2 or -66.67%.

Attempted Murders decreased by 2 or -66.67%.

Assaults decreased by 21 or -10.88%.

Assaults accounted for 95% of reported violent crimes in the second quarter of 2012.

Other Criminal Code

Includes prostitution, gaming/betting, offensive weapons, and other criminal code offences (i.e. arson, property damage, indecent acts, counterfeiting currency etc.)

Offensive Weapons decreased by 6 in the second quarter of 2012 or by -15.38%.

Prostitution offences decreased by 1 in the second quarter of 2012 or by -100%.
