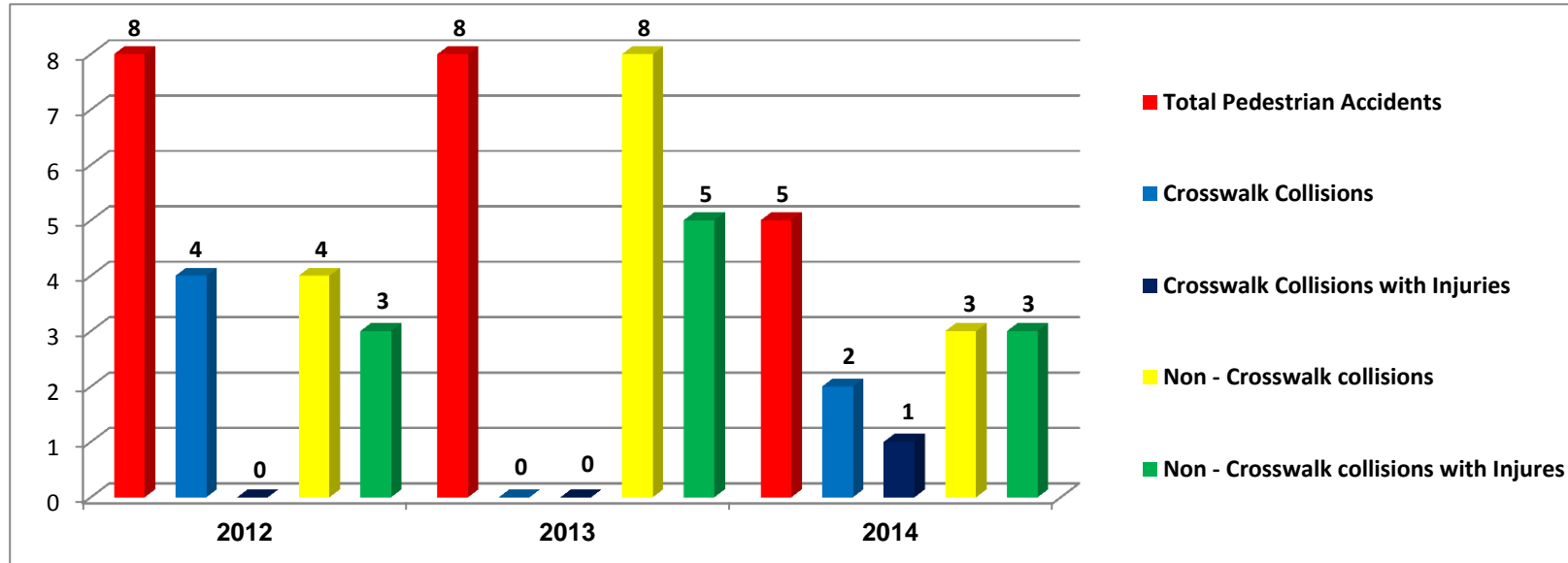

Summary

Pedestrian Accidents

From January 1st - June 30th, 2014, Hfx. District had a total of five pedestrian accidents, a -38% decrease compared to the same period in 2013. Two were in a crosswalk, the remaining three were roadside or crossing outside of a crosswalk. Three of these incidents resulted in one fatality and two with minor injuries. Four occurred during the daylight hours. Two SOTs were issued to the drivers.

April 1st - June 30th, 2014 - Highlights

On April 1st, 2014 Hfx. District's OIC announced the Priorities for the 2014/15 fiscal year's Annual Performance Plan. The three Priorities are identified as Crime Reduction / Youth Intervention, Cybercrime and Traffic.

Crime Reduction / Youth Intervention

Crime Reduction / Youth Intervention continues to move forward by diverting Youth away from court process. Hybrid HUB training including Youth Criminal Justice Act (YCJA) continues with good practices being identified from the first quarter updates.

Cybercrime

Initiatives under this Priority included requesting presentations for District Members from the Provincial Cybersan Unit to aid in reducing impact of Cyber Related Crime.

Traffic

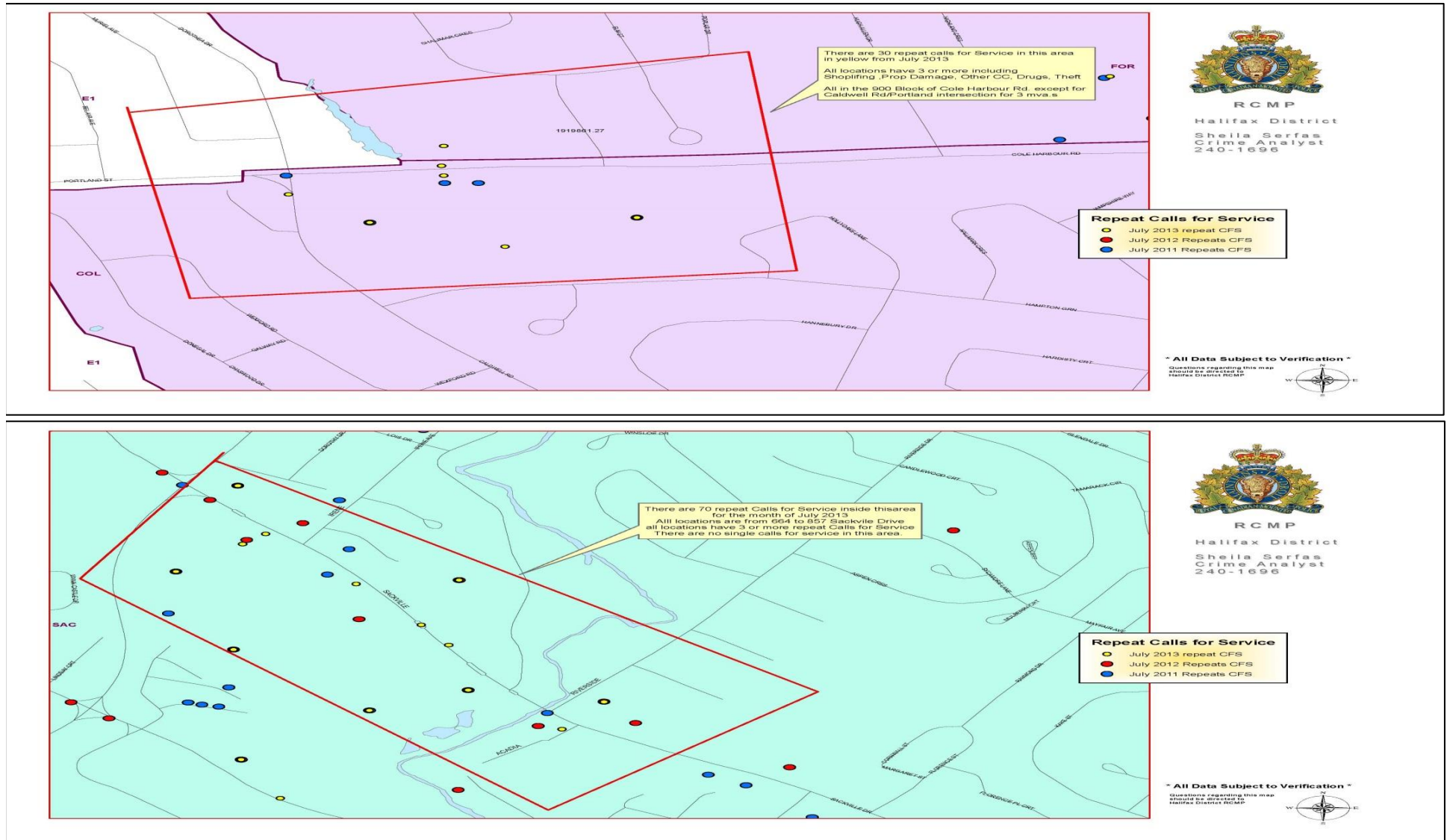
Good initial work completed on this objective. Comstat continues to identify areas of focus for enforcement. Media releases, etc. completed as appropriate for traffic events and updates. Joint check points with Metro Traffic Services have occurred and National Impaired Driving Enforcement Day was well enforced.

Calls for Service



The noted maps indicate repeat locations for Calls for Service for 2011/12/13 for the month of July. This was done under the assumption that if the same locations have had repeat calls for service for the last 3 years then there would be a certain level of expectation that the same would occur in July 2014. With this in mind the District communicated several locations across the District to increase proactive foot patrols, police presence and focused patrols to specific areas. The same intelligence will be communicated with new data for August 2014.
