

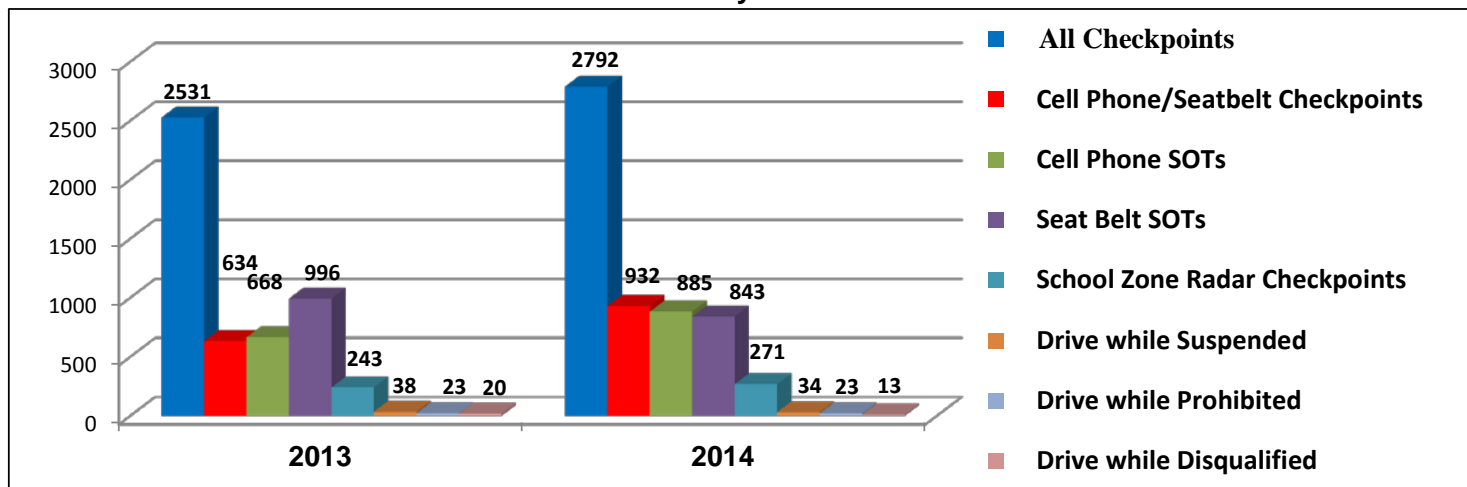

January 1st - November 30th, 2013 - 14 Comparison

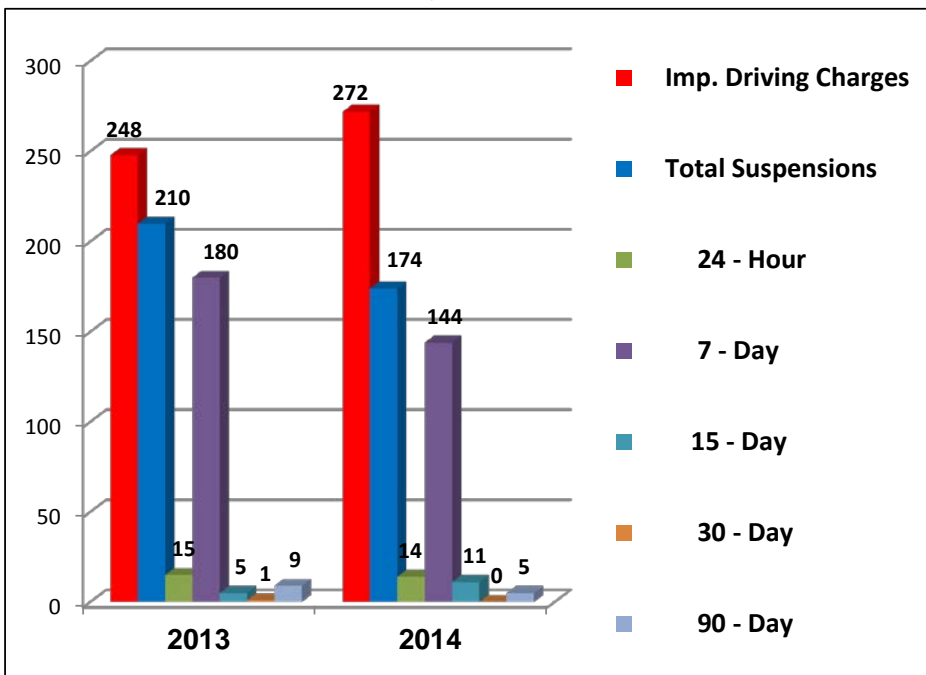

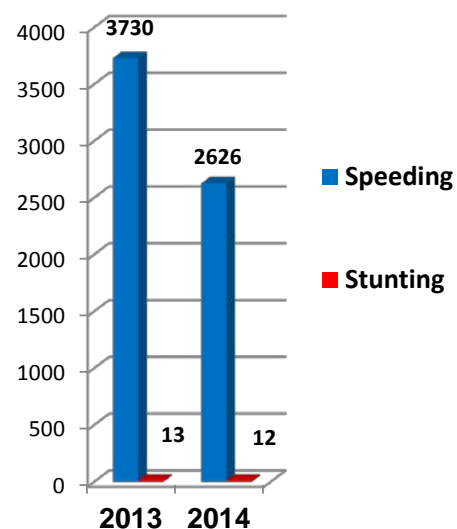

## Summary

### Road Safety

From January 1st - November 30th, 2014, Hfx. District experienced 885 Cell Phone checkpoints, a +47% increase over the same period last year resulting in a +32% increase in the number of SOTs issued. From January 1st - November 30th, 2014 Hfx. District experienced 271 radar enforcement checkpoints held within the school zones, a +11% increase over the same period last year.

### Impaired Driving

From Jan. 1st - Nov. 30th 2014, Hfx. District received one hundred and seventy 911 calls from the public, a -4% decrease over the same period last year resulting in one hundred and ten impaired driving charges and fifteen driving suspensions. From Jan. 1st - Nov. 30th 2014, Hfx. District experienced a +9% increase in impaired driving charges over the same period in 2013. Impaired driving suspensions decreased by -17% over the same period.

### Aggressive Driving

A 10% increase in overall checkpoints, i.e. radar, seat belt etc. was experienced from January 1st - November 30th, 2014 over the same period in 2013 and a decrease of -29% in speeding SOTs was seen.

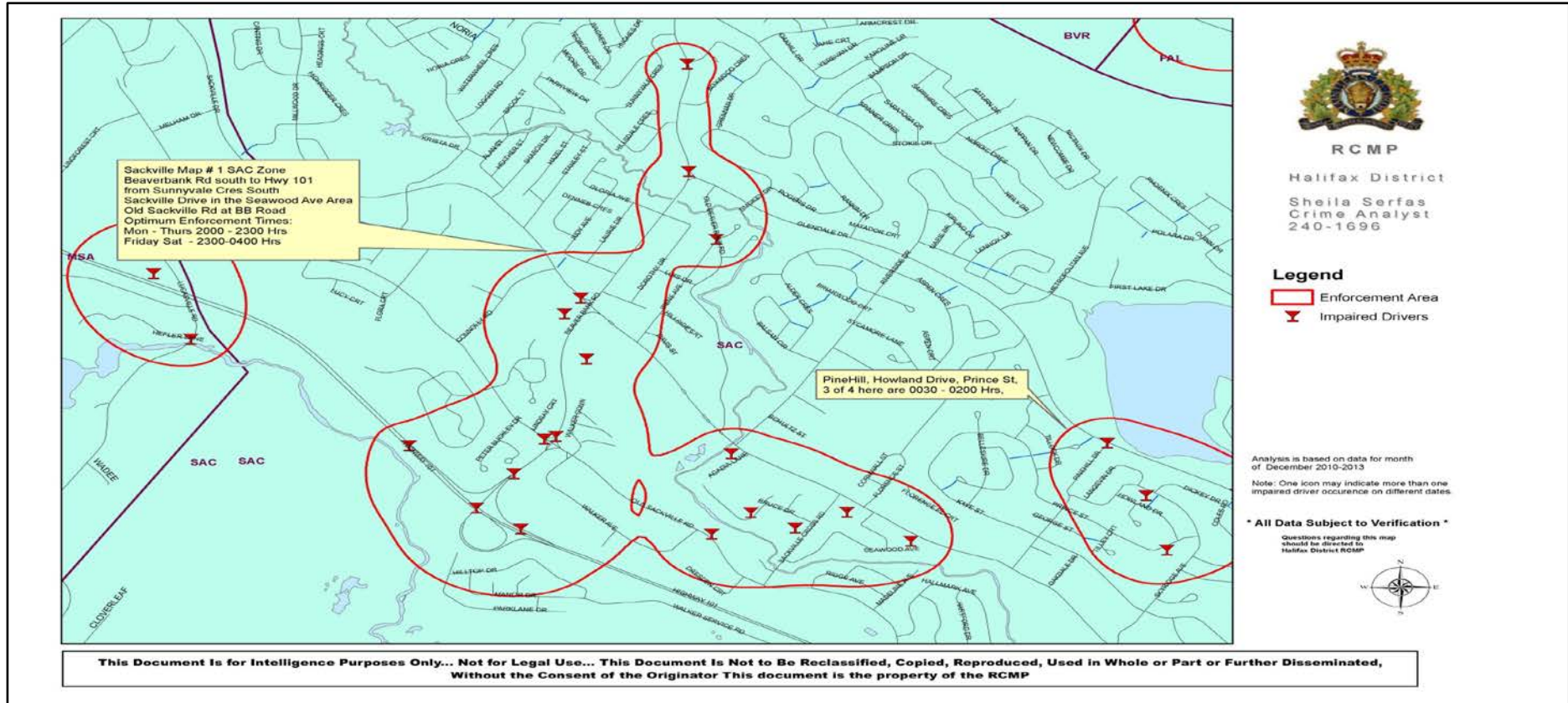

## Impaired Driving



**Crime Reduction** - Halifax District continues to make Impaired Driving Enforcement a priority by analysing all Impaired Driving data including Road Side Suspensions. Impaired data for the month of December was mapped for the last 4 years to identify hotspot locations similar to this one. These maps will be communicated for Officers to apply enforcement where necessary for Halifax District. They are focussed locations with Day of Week and Time of Day, and key days of the month where impaired driving occurred in previous Decembers to ensure we are in the right place during the right time for enforcement. Other initiatives for the month of December will once again focus on Operation Hawkeye distribution as well as key media releases to key business locations across Halifax District to deter anticipated Thefts from Vehicles and encourage the public to keep all valuables out of plain view. Officers will increase presence in the business districts as in previous Decembers, during peak shopping hours over the next several weeks, particularly at locations with historic problems for theft.
