The RCMP Victim Services program in Halifax District is overseen by a Coordinator and includes a roster of 12 volunteers. They follow up with victims of crime via telephone to offer support and referral services. The range of incidents they respond to is very broad and can include suicide, sudden death, assault, domestic violence, sexual assault, break & enter, etc.

For the month of January 2016:

- The Victim Services Coordinator reviewed 247 files this month.
- Victim Services volunteers followed up on 27 files.
- There was 0 files referred to the Department of Justice's Victim Services for follow up, as charges were laid.

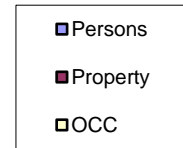
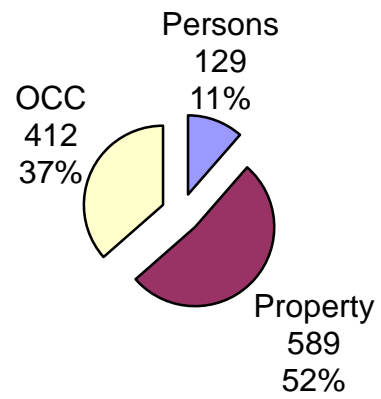


Crimes Against Property 4th Quarter Comparison 2014 - 2015

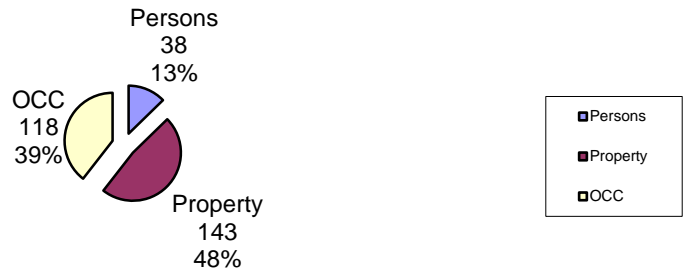

Total Criminal Code offences in the fourth quarter of 2015 show a **decrease** of -117 or by -9.38% compared to the fourth quarter in 2014.

Drugs for the fourth quarter of 2015 **decreased** by -31 or by -25.20% compared to the fourth quarter of 2014.

In the fourth quarter Property offences reported accounted for 52% of Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against Persons accounted for 11% and Other Criminal Code offences accounted for 36%.

Total Criminal Code offences reported in the fourth quarter of 2015 show a **decrease** of -203 reported offences or a **decrease** of -4.01% compared to the fourth quarter of 2014. Drugs in the fourth quarter of 2015 show a **decrease** of -87 offences or a **decrease** of -27.88% compared to the fourth quarter of 2014.

Property offences account for **52%** of the reported Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against Persons account for **12%** and Criminal Other offences account for **36%**.

Property Crimes

Property crime shows an **increase** of +8 reported offences or +0.32%.
