



Halifax Regional Police Environmental Scan 1st Quarter 2016

Total HRP Criminal Code Offences/Drugs

Total Criminal Code offences in the first quarter of 2016 show an increase of +214 or by +6.68% compared to the first quarter of 2015.

Drugs in the first quarter of 2016 decreased by -8 or by -4.40% compared to the first quarter of 2015.

In the first quarter Property offences count for 51% of the Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against Persons account for 13% and Criminal Other offences account for 36%.

First Quarter comparison between 2015 and 2016:

Property Crimes

Overall Property Crime increase by +287 or +19.66%.

Stolen Motor Vehicles decreased by -7 or -12.28%.

Break and Enters increased by +15 or +10.64%.

Frauds increased by +33 or +13.47%.

Violent Crimes

Overall Violent crime decreased by -86 or -16.44%.

Robberies decreased by -6 or -17.65%.

Homicides increased by +4 incidents or +300%.

Attempted Murders increased by +4 or +400%.

Assaults decreased by -89 or -18.43%.

Assaults accounted for 90% of reported violent crimes in the first quarter of 2016.

Criminal Other Code

Includes prostitution, gaming/betting, offensive weapons, and other criminal code offences (arson, property damage, indecent acts, counterfeiting, etc)

Offensive Weapons increased by +16 in the first quarter of 2016 or by +50%

Prostitution offences increased by +4 offences in the first quarter of 2016 or +25%

Please note offences such as drug and prostitution are sensitive to directed enforcement and detection.

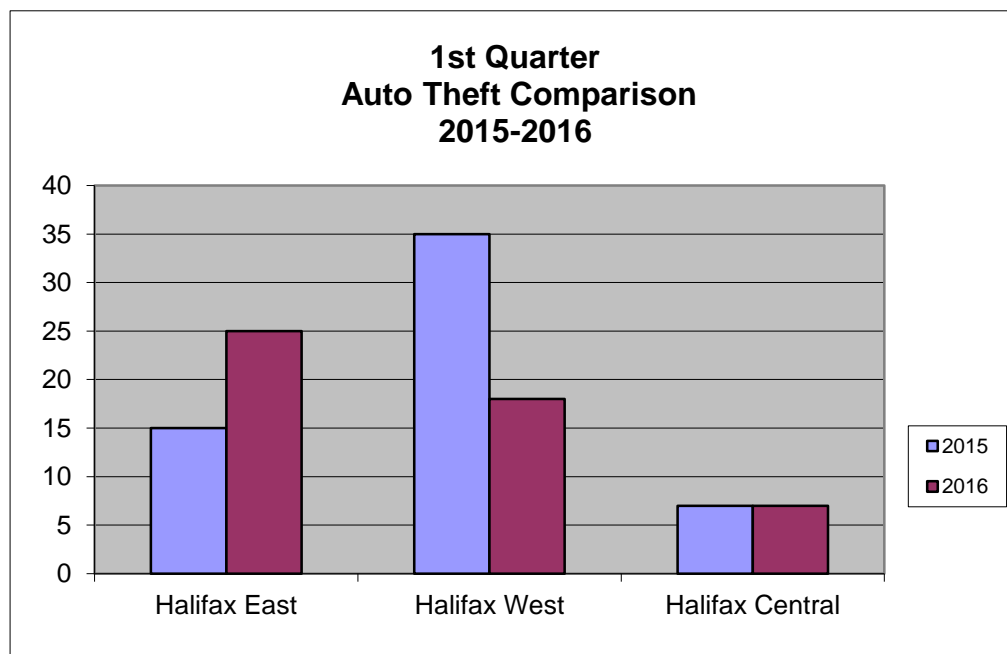
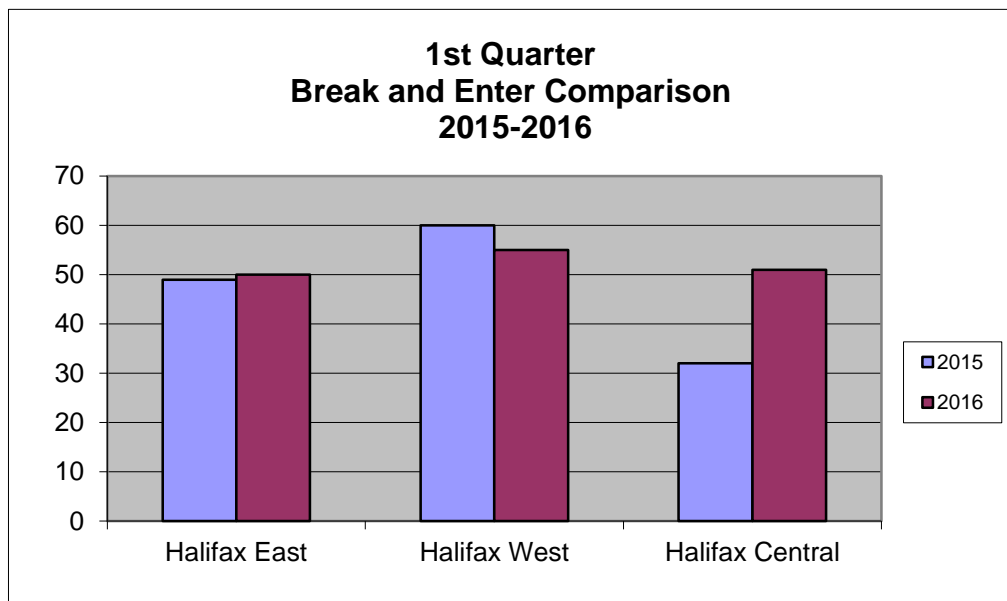

Crimes Against Persons 1st Quarter Comparison



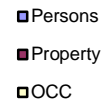
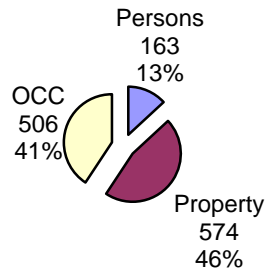
Crimes Against Property 1st Quarter Comparison



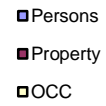
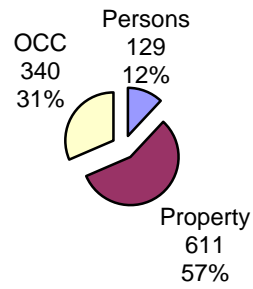
Halifax Regional Police 1st Quarter Regional Stats 2016



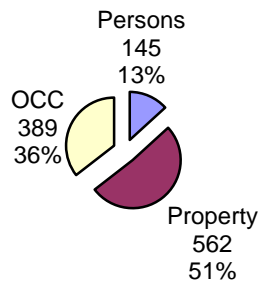
HRP 1st Quarter Stats East

Assaults

Assaults Level 1 accounted for 65% of the total Assaults in the 1st quarter of 2016 compared to 63% in 2015 and experienced a 16% decrease in 2016 over the same period last year.

Assault with a Weapon Causing Bodily Harm accounted for 15% of the total Assaults in 2016 compared to 17% in 2015 and experienced a 30% decrease over the same period last year.

All forms of Sexual Assaults combined accounted for 12% of the total Assaults in 2016 compared to 13% in 2015 and experienced a 24% decrease over the same period last year.

Robberies

Robberies accounted for 6% of the total Persons Crime in the 1ST quarter of 2016 compared to 7% in 2015 and experienced a 16% decrease in 2016 over the same period last year.

Break & Enter

Break & Enter (Residence) accounted for 67% of the total Break & Enters in the 1st quarter of 2016 compared to 47% in 2015 and experienced a 59% increase in 2016 over the same period last year.

Break & Enter (Other) accounted for 12% of the total Break & Enters in the 1st quarter of 2016 compared to 12% in 2015 and experienced a 6% increase in 2016 over the same period last year.

Break & Enter (Business) accounted for 18% of the total Break & Enters in the 1st quarter 2016 compared to 37% in 2015 and experienced a 46% decrease in 2016 over the same period last year.

Theft Under \$5,000

Theft - Other - Under \$5,000 accounted for 76% of the total Theft Under \$5,000 in the 1st quarter 2016 compared to 73% in 2015 and experienced a 31% increase in 2016 over the same period last year.

Theft From Motor Vehicle accounted for 23% of the total Theft Under \$5,000 in the 1st quarter 2016 compared to 24% in 2015 and experienced a 22% increase over the same period last year.

Possession of Stolen Goods experienced a 3% increase in the 1st quarter 2016 over the same period last year.

HRM Policing Services Environmental Scan 1st Quarter 2016



Total HRM Criminal Code Offences/Drugs

Total Criminal Code offences in the first quarter of 2016 show an increase of +394 or by +9.82% compared to the first quarter of 2015.

Drugs in the first quarter of 2016 decreased by -10 or by -3.88% compared to the first quarter of 2015.

In the first quarter Property offences count for 52% of the Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against Persons account for 13% and Criminal Other offences account for 35%.

First Quarter comparison between 2015 and 2016:

Property Crimes

Overall Property Crime increased by +433 or +23.55%.

Stolen Motor Vehicles increased by +1 or +1.23%.

Break and Enters increased by +29 or +14.72%.

Frauds increased by +57 or +18.27%.

Violent Crimes

Overall Violent crime decreased by -53 or -8.37%.

Robberies decreased by -1 or -2.63%.

Homicides remained the same with 4 in the first quarter of 2015 and 2016.

Attempted Murders increased by +4 or +200%.

Assaults decreased by -59 or -10.12%.

Assaults accounted for 90% of reported violent crimes in the first quarter of 2016.

Criminal Other Code

Includes prostitution, gaming/betting, offensive weapons, and other criminal code offences (arson, property damage, indecent acts, counterfeiting, etc)

Offensive Weapons remained the same with 5 in the first quarter of 2015 and 2016.

Prostitution offences increased by +2 offences in the first quarter of 2016 or +11.11%

Please note offences such as drug and prostitution are sensitive to directed enforcement and detection.
