Environmental Scan of 2016 1st Quarter

Total District Criminal Code Offences/Drugs

Total Criminal Code offences in the first quarter of 2016 show a **increase** of +180 or by +22.30% compared to the first quarter in 2015.

Drugs in the first quarter of 2016 **decreased** by -2 or by -2.63% compared to the first quarter of 2015.

In the first quarter Property offences count for 53% of Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against Persons account for 15% and Criminal Other offences account for 32%.

First Quarter comparison between 2015 and 2016:

Property Crimes

Overall Property Crime **increased** by +146 or +38.52%.

Stolen Motor Vehicles **increased** by +8 or +33.33%.

Break and Enters **increased** by +14 or +25%.

Fraud incidents **increased** by +24 or +35.82%.

Violent Crimes

Overall Violent Crime **increased** by +33 or +30%.

Robberies **increased** by +5 or +125%.

Homicides **decreased** by -3 or -100%..

Attempted Murders remained the same at 2.

Assaults **increased** by +30 or +30%.

Assaults accounted for 91% of reported violent crimes in the first quarter of 2016.

Other Criminal Code

Includes prostitution, gaming/betting, offensive weapons, and other criminal code offences (i.e. arson, property damage, indecent acts, counterfeiting currency etc.)

Offensive Weapons **decreased** by -16 in the first quarter of 2016 or by -66.67%.

Prostitution offences **decreased** by -2 in the first quarter of 2016 or by -100%..

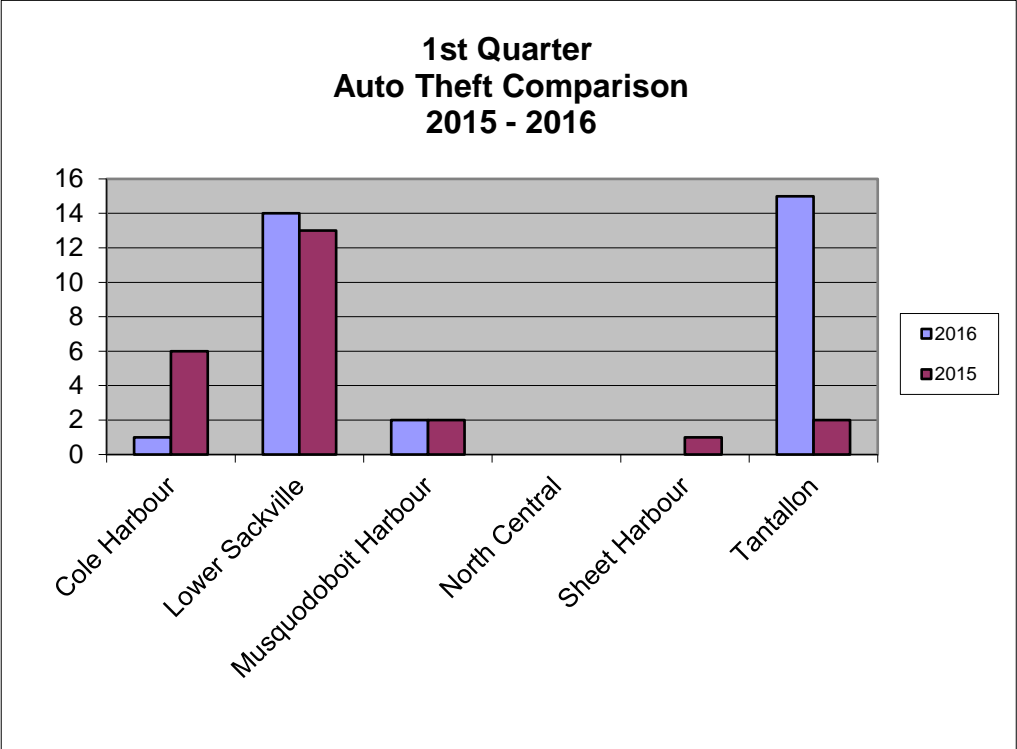

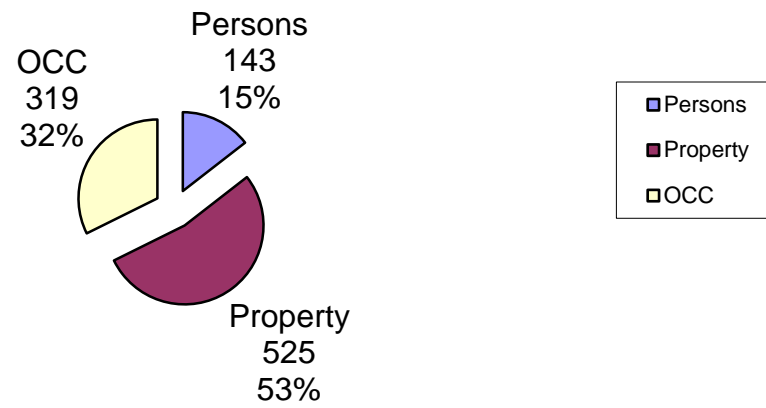
**Crimes Against Persons
1st Quarter Comparison**



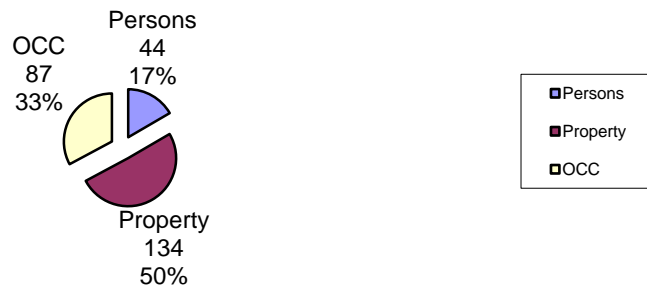
**Crimes Against Property
1st Quarter Comparison**



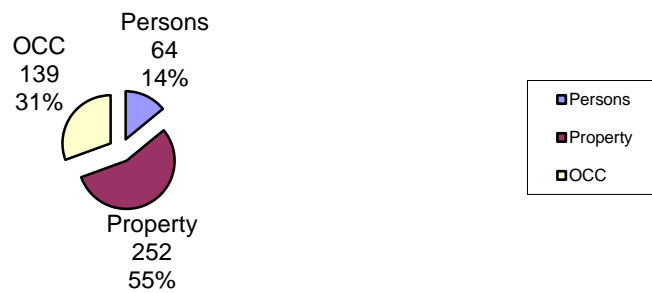
RCMP Halifax District 2016 1st Quarter Stats



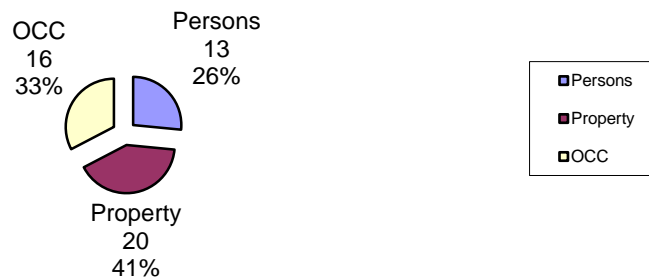
RCMP Halifax District 1st Quarter Stats Cole Harbour



RCMP Halifax District 1st Quarter Stats Lower Sackville



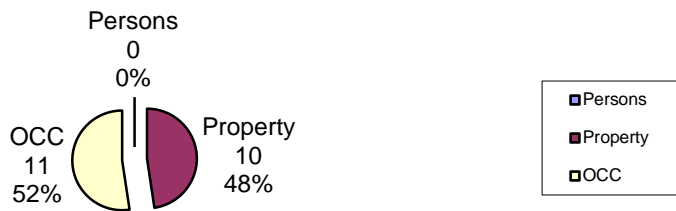
RCMP Halifax District 1st Quarter Stats Musquodoboit Harbour



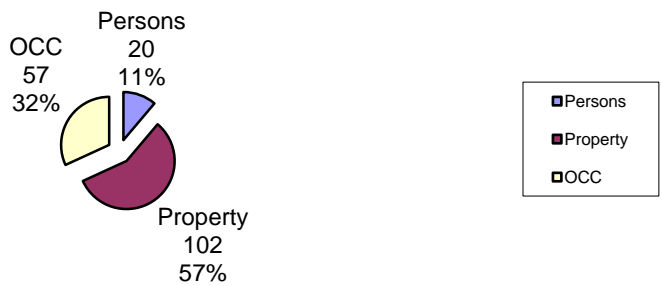

Assaults - Break & Enter - Theft Under

Assaults

Assaults Level 1 accounted for 60% of the total Assaults in the 1st quarter of 2016, the 1st quarter of 2015 had a result of 52% and experienced a +47% **increase** in 2016 over the same period last year.

Assault with a Weapon Causing Bodily Harm accounted for 14% of the total Assaults in 2016 compared to 17% in 2015 and experienced a +6% **increase** over the same period last year.

All forms of Sexual Assaults combined accounted for 21% of the total Assaults in 2016 compared to 20% in 2015.

Robberies accounted for 6% of the total Persons Crime in the 1st quarter of 2016 compared to 4% in 2015 and experienced a +125% **increase** in 2016 over the same period last year.

Break & Enter

Break & Enter (Residence) accounted for 49% of the total Break & Enters in the 1st quarter of 2016 compared to 64% in 2015 and experienced -6% **decrease** in the 1st quarter of 2016 compared to the same period last year.

Break & Enter (Other) accounted for 37% of the total Break & Enters in 2016 1st quarter compared to 23% in 2015 and experienced a +100 **increase** over the same period last year.

Break & Enter (Business) accounted for 14% of the total Break & Enters in the 1st quarter 2016 compared to 13% in 2015 and experienced a +43% **increase** in 2016 over the same period last year.

Theft Under \$5,000

Theft Other Under \$5,000 accounted for 49% of the total Theft Under \$5,000 in the 1st quarter 2016 compared to 66% in 2015 and experienced a +8% **increase** in 2016 over the same period last year.

Theft from Motor Vehicle under \$5,000 accounted for 41% of the total Theft Under \$5,000 in the 1st quarter 2016 compared to 24% in 2015 and experienced a +145% **increase** over the same period last year.

Possession of Stolen Goods **increased** by 1 incident or 20% in the 1st quarter of 2016 when compared to the same period last year.

Shoplifting Under \$5,000 experienced a -100% **decrease** in the 1st quarter 2016 over the same period last year.

Total HRM Criminal Code Offences/Drugs

Total Criminal Code offences in the first quarter of 2016 show an increase of +394 or by +9.82% compared to the first quarter of 2015.

Drugs in the first quarter of 2016 decreased by -10 or by -3.88% compared to the first quarter of 2015.

In the first quarter Property offences count for 52% of the Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against Persons account for 13% and Criminal Other offences account for 35%.

First Quarter comparison between 2015 and 2016:

Property Crimes

Overall Property Crime increased by +433 or +23.55%.

Stolen Motor Vehicles increased by +1 or +1.23%.

Break and Enters increased by +29 or +14.72%.

Frauds increased by +57 or +18.27%.

Violent Crimes

Overall Violent crime decreased by -53 or -8.37%.

Robberies decreased by -1 or -2.63%.

Homicides remained the same with 4 in the first quarter of 2015 and 2016.

Attempted Murders increased by +4 or +200%.

Assaults decreased by -59 or -10.12%.

Assaults accounted for 90% of reported violent crimes in the first quarter of 2016.

Criminal Other Code

Includes prostitution, gaming/betting, offensive weapons, and other criminal code offences (arson, property damage, indecent acts, counterfeiting, etc)

Offensive Weapons remained the same with 5 in the first quarter of 2015 and 2016.

Prostitution offences increased by +2 offences in the first quarter of 2016 or +11.11%

Please note offences such as drug and prostitution are sensitive to directed enforcement and detection.
