
Crimes Against Persons 3rd Quarter Comparison 2015 - 2016




























Total District Criminal Code Offences/Drugs

<u>Total Criminal Code</u> offences in the third quarter of 2016 show a **decrease** of -66 or -5.01% compared to the third quarter in 2015.

<u>Drugs</u> for the third quarter of 2016 **decreased** by -21 or -19.27% compared to the third quarter of 2015.

In the third quarter <u>Property offences</u> count for 50% of Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against <u>Persons</u> account for 12% and <u>Criminal Other</u> offences account for 38%.

Third Quarter comparison between 2015 and 2016:

Property Crimes

Overall Property Crime increased by +69 or +12.28%.

Stolen Motor Vehicles **increased** by +13 or +37.14%.

Break and Enters **decreased** by -11 or -12.09%.

Fraud incidents **increased** by +10 or +16.13%.

Violent Crimes

Overall Violent Crime **decreased** by -29 or -16.67%.

Robberies decreased by -12 or -75%.

Homicides remained the same at 1.

Attempted Murders **increased** by -1 or +100%.

Assaults **decreased** by -19 or -12.18%.

Assaults accounted for 95% of reported violent crimes in the third quarter of 2016.

Other Criminal Code

Includes prostitution, gaming/betting, offensive weapons, and other criminal code offences (i.e. arson, property damage, indecent acts, counterfeiting currency etc.)

Offensive Weapons decreased by -15 in the third quarter of 2016 or by -62.5%.

Prostitution offences remained the same at 0 in both the third quarter of 2015 and 2016.

Assaults

Assaults Level 1 accounted for 70% of the total <u>Assaults</u> in the 3^{rd} quarter of 2016, the 3^{rd} quarter of 2015 had a result of 60% and experienced a +2% **increase** in 2016 over the same period last year.

Assault with a Weapon Causing Bodily Harm accounted for 14% of the total <u>Assaults</u> in 2016 compared to 21% in 2015 and experienced a -41% **decrease** over the same period last year.

All forms of Sexual Assaults combined accounted for 12% of the total <u>Assaults</u> in 2016 compared to 16% in 2015.

Theft Under \$5,000

Theft - Other Under \$5,000 accounted for 59% of the total <u>Theft Under \$5,000</u> in the 3rd quarter of 2016 compared to 56% 2015, experiencing a +21% **increase** in 2016 over the same period last year.

Theft from Motor Vehicle under \$5,000 accounted for 40% of the total <u>Theft Under \$5,000</u> in the 3^{rd} quarter 2016 compared to 40% in 2015 and experienced a +15% **increase** over the same period last year.

Possession of Stolen Goods experienced a -26% **decrease** in the 3rd quarter 2016 over the same period last year.

Theft of Bicycle experienced a -73% **decrease** in the 3rd quarter 2016 over the same period last year.

Total HRM Criminal Code Offences/Drugs

Total Criminal Code offences reported in the third quarter of 2016 show a **decrease** of **-199** reported offences or **-3.6%** compared to the third quarter of 2015. Drugs for third quarter 2016 show a **decrease** of **-13** offences or **-4.73%** compared to third quarter 2015.

Property offences account for **50%** of the reported Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against Persons account for **13%** and Criminal Other offences account for **37%**.

Property Crimes

Property crime shows a decrease of -74 reported offences or -2.72%.

Stolen motor vehicles decreased by -7 offences or -6.54%.

Break and Enters decreased by -76 offences or -21.9%.

Frauds increased by +10 offences or +3.57%.

Violent Crimes

Violent crime has experienced a **decrease** in the third quarter of 2016 compared to 2015 by **-37** offences or a change of **-4.91%**.

Robberies decreased by -6 offences or a change of -9.52%.

Homicides decreased by -3 incidents in 2016 compared to the third quarter of 2015 or -60%.

Attempted murders remained unchanged reporting three in the third quarter of 2015 and 2016.

Assaults **decreased** by **-30** offences or a change of **-4.45%**. Assaults accounted for **90%** of violent crimes in the third quarter of 2016.

Criminal Other

Includes prostitution, gaming/betting, offensive weapons, and other criminal code offences (arson, property damage, indecent acts, counterfeiting, etc.) has **decreased** by **-88** or **-4.34%**.

Prostitution offences decreased by -8 offences in the third quarter of 2016 over 2015 or -88.8%.

Please note offences such as drug and prostitution are sensitive to directed enforcement and detection.
