## **ANNUAL REPORT**

#### **ORIGIN**

Section 27 (1) of the HRM Charter states:

A community council shall hold an annual public meeting in the community in each year to report to the public any concerning its activities and to receive the vires of the public respecting all matters within its mandate.

North West Community Council requested that the Legislative Assistant maintain a record of the Community Council's business for the first annual meeting held in 2013 and annually held thereafter.

#### **BACKGROUND**

The North West Community Council was established on December 3, 2012. Community Councils consider local matters such as planning applications or variance appeals, make recommendations to Regional Council, and provide opportunities for public input.

North West Community Council includes the following polling districts:

District 1: Waverly – Fall River – Musquodoboit – (Councillor Barry Dalrymple)

District 13: Hammonds Plains – St. Margaret's Bay – (Councillor Matt Whitman)

District 14: Middle/Upper Sackville – Beaver Bank – Lucasville – (Councillor Brad Johns)

District 15: Lower Sackville – (Councillor Steve Craig)

District 16: Bedford – Wentworth – (Councillor Tim Outhit)

## **DISCUSSION**

On November 27, 2012 Regional Council passed a motion to create the three new Community Councils. Initially, the North West Community Council was known as the Central Community Council. The new Central Community Council passed a motion on December 13, 2012 to change the name from Central to North West Community Council to better reflect the communities contained in the Community Council boundaries.

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Councillors Brad Johns, Tim Outhit, Barry Dalrymple, Matt Whitman and Steve Craig met as the North West Community Council (NWCC) within various locations within the five districts.

The new North West Community Council held one meeting in December of 2012 and every month of 2013. Special meetings were held in January, April and September.

The following will highlight North West Community Council's business since the first meeting in December 2012.

### Motions:

Motion passed to nominate Councillor Johns as Chair and Councillor Outhit as Vice-Chair of Central Community Council.

### **New Community Council Structure – Administrative Matters**

Motion passed that Central Community Council approves the following administrative direction for the operation of Community Council:

- 1. To set a standard meeting start time of 7 p.m. for regular meetings of Community Council.
- 2. That the proposed schedule of Community Council meetings which includes a set of monthly meeting date and a date for an additional meeting per month (as/if required).
- 3. That the regular monthly meeting be held at various locations to be announced and any additional meetings required due to public hearings be held at a location within the community that facilitates public access.
- 4. Change the name of Central Community Council to North West Community Council.

- Delete Section 3.3.2 (a) and replace with: 3.3.2 (a) The combined maximum floor area used for seating, including any exterior patio and/or deck seating area shall not exceed 1,500 square feet.
- Delete Section 3.3.3(a) and replace with: 3.3.3(a) The combined maximum gross floor area used for seating, including any exterior patio and/or deck seating area shall not exceed 1,500 square feet.
- Delete Section 5.1.1(a) and replace with: 5.1.1(a) An increase to the maximum gross floor area used for seating, beyond that enabled by sections 3.3.2(a) and 3.3.3(a), provided the increased area does not result in a change or alteration to the footprint of the building.
- Delete the words 'Downtown Dartmouth' and replace with "Hammonds Plains, Beaver Bank and Upper Sackville" in Section 6.4.1(d).
- Amend Section 3.7.1 Landscaping Plan as follows: Further to subsection 3.2.1(b), prior to the issuance of a Development Permit, the developer agrees to provide a Landscaping Plan. The Landscaping Plan shall comply with all provisions of this section.
- Require the agreement be signed by the property owner within 120 days, or any extension thereof granted by Council on request of the property owner, from the date of approval by Council and any other bodies as necessary, including applicable appeal periods, whichever is later; otherwise this approval will be void and obligations arising hereunder shall be at an end.

November 18, 2013

#### • Case 17760: Development Agreement – 644 Bedford Highway, Halifax

Public Hearing held and closed. North West Community Council deferred decision on this matter until the December 16, 2013 meeting requesting a supplementary staff report to include:

- Better understanding of the current use and possibilities for the 'Old Coach Road' trail.
- Staff to discuss with the developer the possibility of a sidewalk to be included in the development.
- Traffic services to be contacted to see if traffic lights are warranted at the intersection of Bedros Lane, Larry Uteck Boulevard and Starboard Drive.
- Consideration of turning lanes on Bedford Highway at locations near the proposed development.

- Request to have developer provide a sketch of the proposed building in relation to the various view planes.

## **Public Participation**

• Speakers noted traffic issues at Pockwock Road including a number of accidents and crosswalk is not cleared after snowstorms.

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- Speaker concerned with lack of traffic lights at the corner of Glen Arbor and Hammonds Plains Road.
- Speaker requested members of NWCC to lobby Halifax Regional Council to acquire HRM portion of the Hantsport Rail line. Speaker also requested that Council make an effort to reinstate water quality testing in HRM lakes.
- Speaker raised concern regarding Land Use Bylaws around his home based property.
- Speaker raised concern regarding the definition of 'traditional built' in the Municipal Planning Strategy.
- Speaker requested information as to when Pine Hill Brook water protection would take place and if there would be drinking water made available to the residents of McCabes North.
- Speaker advised that local trail association was building their trails towards the Hanstport Rail Line. Added that long commutes and limited parking in the downtown core was affecting business.
- Speaker requested that Council consider commuter rail. Also was encouraged by the Margeson Drive update and hoped Council would consider a Park and Ride facility in the Hammonds Plains area.
- Speaker wanted to know the status of the Regional Watershed Advisory Board and when it would begin its work. Also noted shoulder of Pockwock Road needed to be fixed.
- Speaker requested information if water and sewer services would be extended to McCabe's Lake. Also invited Councillors to local Duck Race, a fundaraiser being hosted by Acadia Hall and Boys and Girls clubs.
- Speaker concerned about Water Quality monitoring and wanted it to be reinstated.
- Speaker noted difficulty navigating the HRM website and how some information seemed to vanish from the site. Also advised that a large pile of cut wood was left behind by contractors in the Voyageur Lakes area. Speaker advised 311 was contacted but there was no way to determine when the issue would be looked after.
- Speaker did not like the idea of changing water setbacks to 30 meters without good justification.
- Speaker pleased that NWCC invited Mr. Austin French to discuss the RP+5 (Regional Plan) review. Also added that the plan did not have a committed action plan for wastewater management.
- A number of speakers submitted suggestions to Mr. French to consider for the Regional Plan review.
- Speakers raised concerns regarding trucks on the Hammonds Plains Road and Bylaw T-400.
- Speaker advised there was a large rut on Yankeetown Road that needed to be filled in.

## Public Participation continued

- Speaker inquired about the status of a bus service for the Lucasville Road; requested changes to the tenancy act, specifically related to mobile home parks, that Bylaw service direct dangerous and unsightly orders be the renter's responsibility not the land owner. Also wanted to know the status of the community signs being placed in Lucasville.
- Speaker raised concerns about a proposed roundabout being suggested for the intersection of Kearney Lake Road and Larry Uteck Boulevard.
- Speaker raised concern about possibility of offsite leachate being sent to Highway 101 Leachate treatment facility.
- MLA Bill Horne spoke during the public participation noting he hoped to work alongside Council and address issues and concerns.
- Students from Dalhousie University Community Design Program attended a North West Community Council meeting and thanked Council for allowing them to observe the proceedings.
- Speakers concerned about the development of a casino in the Hammonds Plains area.
- Members of the Lucasville Residents Association attended and raised concerns regarding cultural heritage, community signage, community boundaries, need for upgraded infrastructure and bus service.
- Speaker discussed the difficulty operating a small business.
