Ms. Edmonds: I sent your referral from NWCC to Norma Bennett who is presently acting for Adrian Fuller. I did speak to inspector Colleen Smith who did review the correspondence of November 21, 2007, from SRA to Councillor Brad Johns. Colleen has been to the site in the area and including Lawson Estates located on the Old Sackville Road. Works undertaken by 3099555 Nova Scotia Limited at this location have contributed silt/sediment to a tributary to the Little Sackville River. As a result, the department issued a directive under s.71 of the Environment Act requiring the owner to install several erosion control measures to mitigate the release of sediment. We are continuing to follow-up with this company and will keep you apprised as inspections continue. Please advise Councillor Johns.
