BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION:

On June 14, 2005, the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board decided to uphold the July 12, 2004 decision of Peninsula Community Council to approve the development agreement with Westwood Developments Limited and to dismiss the appeal by Elie Chater, Almon Investments and James Caven et al.. The development agreement allows for a mixed-residential development on 6.7 acres of land fronting on Gladstone and Clifton Streets, Halifax.

Staff will now send the approved development agreement to the applicant for signature.
