## PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS the Look Good Feel Better program has been successful in assisting more than 350,000 Canadian women living with cancer over the past ten years; and

WHEREAS the Look Good Feel Better program provides women with cancer education through two-hour workshops at 65 hospitals and cancer care facilities, and Look Good Feel Better seminars in regions outside of major centres, free program materials including an annual magazine; and


WHEREAS more than 1,500 voluntuer cosmeticians, health care professionals and concerned individuals participate to make the program successful; and
